

The Devotion of Discipleship

Disciples of Jesus Christ are devoted to loving others unconstrained by limits and loving Jesus by drawing near and listening. This passage confronts us with our human tendency to limit love for others and be distracted in our devotion to Jesus. It shows us that as disciples we are to expand our understanding and practice of love for neighbour and be clear about what is most important in expressing love for Jesus.

Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD THAT HE IS A SAVING

GOD. That He would look upon us in rebellion and sin with compassion and grace—and then send His one and only Son to die in our place, forgive our sins, and reconcile us back into fellowship with Him. Praise God!

PRAY THAT THE JOY OF OUR

SALVATION, and the joy of missions, would continue to drive us to evangelise and share the great news of Jesus' death and resurrection. Pray that we would rely upon and be empowered by the Spirit to have courage to speak and press on in mission together. Pray that God would be pleased to use our words—no matter how imperfect—to draw more and more into His eternal kingdom.

PRAY THAT WE WOULD BE PEOPLE MARKED BY EXPANSIVE LIMITLESS

LOVE FOR OTHERS. Pray that today's passage would confront our tendency to limit our love for others and be distracted in our devotion to Jesus. Pray for transformation of our hearts and desires to be lived in conformity to our Saviour's mind and life.

PRAY FOR THE STUDENTS AMONG US WHO ARE IN THE MIDST OF EXAMS.

Pray that they would not only study diligently but also study with thankfulness for the privilege of studies and education. Pray that the students would also give thanks that their studies have opened opportunities to learn about God's creation order. Pray also that they would continue to prioritise communion with God and not neglect fellowship in this time.

PRAY FOR EACH OTHER'S ENERGY LEVELS AS WE DRAW CLOSER AND CLOSER TO THE END OF THE YEAR.

Pray for many of us who are physically and emotionally tired. Pray for refreshing times of fellowship with God and with each other. Pray also for good times of rest.
