The Unhelpfulness of Narrow Wisdom

Job's friends' wisdom about suffering is wrong in content and attitude. True wisdom that comforts and helps consists of proper understanding as well as humility and grace. That is, true wisdom is both theological and relational.

Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD THAT HE IS SOVEREIGN, IN CONTROL, AND REMAINS LOVING

AND CARING even in the face of immense suffering. Praise God that no evil desire of Satan can thwart God's plans and purposes. Praise God that in Job 1-2 we have seen His sovereign purposes extending to using the evil motives of Satan for His greater glory.

PRAY THAT WE WOULD WRESTLE WITH. BELIEVE. AND EMBRACE THE

TRUTH that the glory of God is more important than Job's, or our, personal comfort. Pray that this would thrust us to depend upon and hold fast to the gospel—remembering that our Saviour gave up His comfort for us, that we might live in eternal bliss with God forever.

PRAY FOR OURSELVES AS WE ENCOUNTER SUFFERING IN EACH

OTHER'S LIVES. As we reflect upon the words and advice of Job's friends pray that we would grow in wisdom to not stumble as they did. Pray that we would be people who show our care and love with appropriate words at the appropriate time.

PRAY FOR THE UPCOMING LEADER'S RETREAT AND THE MANY MEMBERS OF OUR CHURCH HEADING AWAY

FOR IT. Pray that the organisation of the retreat will continue to go smoothly.
