Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD THAT IN PURSUING HIS CHIEF MISSION of glorifying Himself He has made a way for us to be saved: forgiven and reconciled to Him, empowered, to do His work, and eternally secured. Praise God that this work accomplished in Jesus is given to us freely and graciously!

PRAY THAT WE WOULD RESPOND WITH CHRIST-CENTRED LIVING. That in all of our lives our decision will be marked by an earnest desire to please and obey God. Pray that God would give us wisdom and humility to heed wise counsel. Pray that we would be faithfully on mission in every stage of life—seeking opportunities to share the good news of Jesus, disciple others, and immerse ourselves in the greatness of our Trinitarian God.

PRAY THAT WE WOULD BE EXPOSITORY LISTENERS— those who desire to know God's message and purpose within each given passage of Scripture. Pray that we would listen to sermons well—hearing not just what we enjoy, nor just what we want, but that God's Spirit would soften and convict our hearts by the truths of Scripture. Pray that our listening to God's Word preached would flow out in obedience, holiness, and good works.

Pray that we would take opportunities in each others' lives to hear our stories of grace, and to prayerfully encourage each other.
