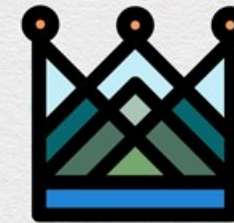

### **PRAISE GOD FOR HIS KINDNESS**

in teaching us so much about the Day of the Lord (i.e. Jesus' second coming), so that we can be ready for it! Praise God for His patience in always warning of impending judgement, rather than just wiping people out before they have the opportunity to repent.

### **THANK GOD FOR OPENING OUR**

**EARS** to hear the warning of judgement that we deserve, and giving us humble hearts to repent and believe in Jesus.

Thank Jesus for His willingness to face rejection and suffering to the point of death on a cross, to take on the punishment that we deserved.

### **PRAY THAT DESPITE THE BUSYNESS**

and distraction of life, we would not forget or ignore the reality that the day of the Lord is drawing near, and could dawn at any moment. Pray that on that day, each of us would eagerly go with Jesus, not turning back or lingering over any of the good gifts we enjoyed in this world—whether our homes, our jobs, our friends or even our families. Pray that now, God would help loosen our grip on these things, especially if they have become the central focus of our lives and loves.
