

The Arrival of the King

Christ is seen in divine power and humility which will bring about glorious peace. Those who belong to Jesus can have confidence in King Jesus, knowing that His power and humility is why we can have God's peace. Let this lead us to joyful worship and hopeful confidence. Let those who have rejected Him in the past come to Him in worship while there is still time.
