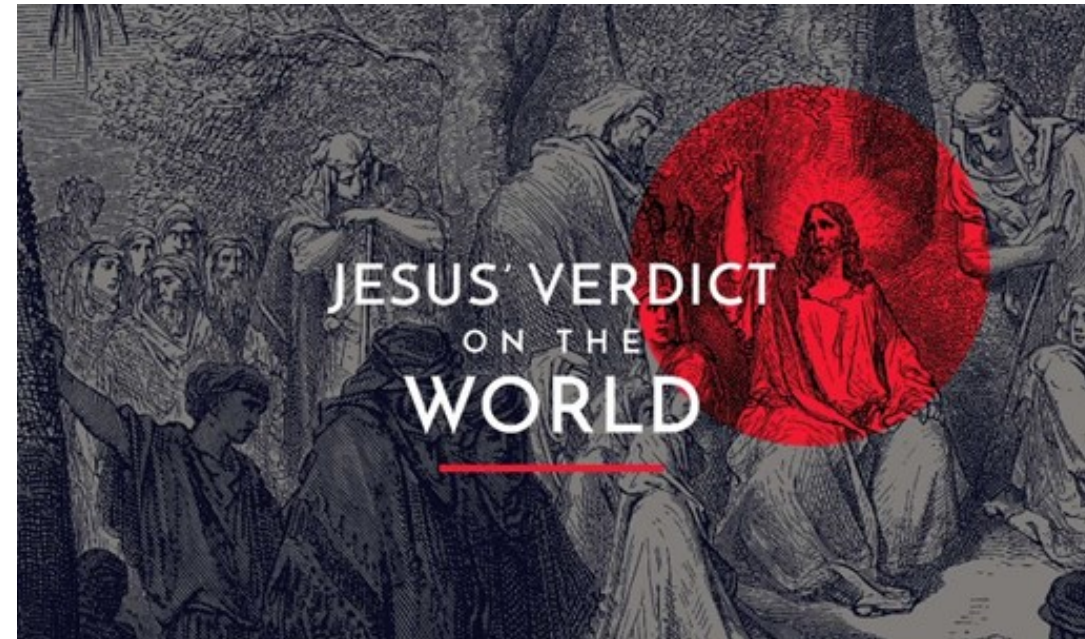

PRAISE GOD FOR HIS WORD TO US

which brings life and light. Praise our Lord Jesus Christ who as we saw in last week's passage, revealed the hearts of false teachers who seek their own attention and benefit. Thank Him for also pointing out the heart of someone who is a wonderful example of what it means to be all-in for God.

PRAY THAT WE WOULD BE WISE

in discerning false teachers and not be attracted to their teaching. Instead, ask that we would be faithful in depending on and trusting in our Lord Jesus for our life and salvation. Ask that God will reveal what is stopping us from trusting and following Jesus wholly and fully, and for help to overcome them.

THANK GOD THAT THE LEADERS

of the church were able to meet yesterday to consider what church planting might look like. Ask God for wisdom and for His help in implementing the plan.

PRAY FOR THE VARIOUS FELLOWSHIP GROUPS

that have recently restarted or will be starting soon. Pray that members in the groups will grow in their faith in Jesus, and that their bonds of fellowship will strengthen as they study and do life together under God's word.

PRAY FOR THE FAMILIES

with school-aged children as school starts tomorrow: for patience and forbearance as they adapt and adjust to a new routine. Pray also for Kids Church as they restart next Sunday. Pray for the teachers to prepare well for their lessons, and for God to work in hearts of children to see Jesus clearer.
