

In a time of great trouble for Israel, Nehemiah prays a big prayer with big concerns: confessing sin and hoping that God will keep His word.

Prayer Points

GIVE PRAISE TO THE LORD OF ALL

POWER! Give praise to the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords! Praise God that He demonstrated His power through humanly impossible rescues of His prophets, apostles and servants throughout history. Praise the Lord for showing us that human ruler or indeed any spiritual power, authority or force amounts to anything in comparison. Praise the Lord that His power is most fully revealed through His resurrection from the dead, His ascension back into heaven, and His ongoing rule as He sits on His throne in heaven. Praise the Lord that His rule is seen in the global growth of the gospel, empowered by His holy Spirit, working in the world, and working through His disciples.

GIVE THANKS THAT WE HAVE BEEN GIVEN THE GOSPEL, THE WORD OF

LIFE, salvation through Jesus Christ. Give thanks that we have such good news to share with the world—a world filled with sinners, living in rebellion against their creator, and experiencing brokenness and pains of many kinds. Give thanks that the gospel has gone out from Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and to the ends of the world. Give thanks that the gospel has come to us. Give thanks that the gospel can and will continue to go out through us, wherever we may be or go.

PRAY FOR OUR PRAYERS TO BE TRANSFORMED TO REFLECT THE GOD AND LORD WE PRAY TO.

Pray for faith to believe that God can do anything according to His will. Pray big and bold prayers that God will bring glory to Himself, that His will be done, that the lost will be saved, that the faithful would persevere, with certain hope that our eternal deliverance is assured.
