In Nehemiah's return to rebuild Jerusalem, God's good hand works to provide and protect. Know that God has always been and will always be at work to sovereignly bring about His purposes, fulfilling His promises, through various means; we see this most clearly in the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. God's good hand continues to be with us as we seek to do the work of the Lord—we can trust Him and press on in service.

Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD FOR THE GOOD NEWS THAT IN CHRIST GOD HAS FULFILLED HIS PROMISES. Praise God that none of His words have failed, nor will fail, but the resurrection of Jesus secures God's promises in the past and for the future. Praise God that we can trust God for His present promises to us.

PRAY THAT WE WOULD BE PEOPLE MARKED BY OPEN, HONEST AND CONFIDENT CONFESSION.

Pray that our confidence would be rooted in the gospel—a confidence of children who know their loving heavenly Father responds with steadfast love and covenantal faithfulness. Pray that we would respond to each other with the same gospel-centred compassion we have received from God.

CONTINUE TO PRAY FOR A THIRD PASTOR, AND FOR THE POTENTIAL CANDIDATES WE HAVE.

Pray that God would give our elders and council wisdom in finding a suitable candidate. Pray that God would also raise up the right man for the work, and that he would not only be suitably qualified (in character and gifts) but also be of a personality that would work well with our staff, council, and church.

PRAISE GOD FOR ORGANISATIONS SUCH AS REACH AUSTRALIA AND THE FELLOWSHIP OF INDEPENDENT EVANGELICAL CHURCHES.

Praise God that these organisations exist to train and equip pastors and church leaders to grow disciples of Jesus. Praise God for the training and development that both Pastor Ben and Steven have experienced over the past weeks and months. Pray that the tools learned would be of great benefit in growing them personally, and our church not only in number but also in depth and maturity.
