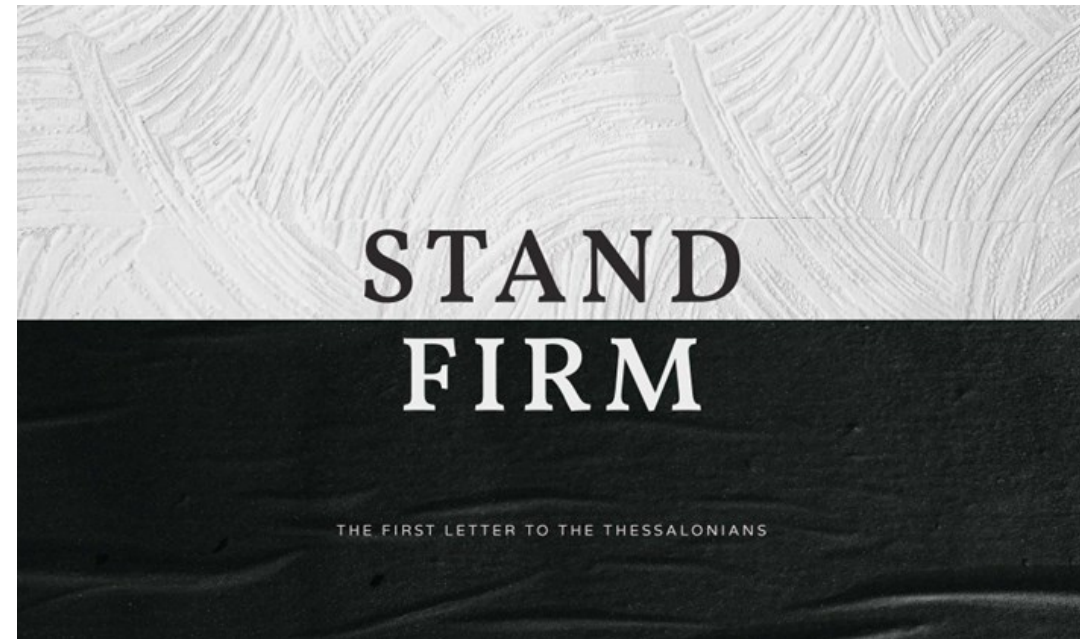

Standing firm needs:

1. Unity (v12-13)
 - a. Loving your pastors (!!)

b. Being at peace

2. Effort (14-22)
 - a. Admonish, encourage, help, with patience

b. Do good, not evil

c. Rejoice and Pray

d. Do not quench the Spirit

3. Grace (23-28)
 - a. God's faithful sanctifying work in your whole being

b. Starting by grace, finishing by grace
