Praise God that satisfaction in life comes as a good gift from his hands! Pray for the ways in which our world - and we - try to seek out satisfaction for ourselves. Pray that we would not strive for or seek to gain satisfaction through the means of purpose, health and well-being, financial security, or even in friends and family. Pray that we would grow in what it means to know, love, and fear the Lord - and through gospel living seek a life of sacrifice and service of others. Pray that our satisfaction would be deeply rooted in the gospel and in knowing and being known by God.

Praise God for the start of the new school year! Pray for the children and families among our church to rejoice in the things they are learning - for how God has ordered this world and the ways in which we have been able to discover this. Pray that we would see education as not just a means to bettering our own lives, but as a way to worship God by rejoicing in his good order and creation. Pray that this would lead to right priorities for our families and students - to seek God first in all that they do.

Pray for those among us who are not doing well. For those who are unwell - whether with physical pains, chronic pains, or struggles with their mental health.
