Right Judgement

Followers of Jesus are challenged to demonstrate right judgement through righteous, wise, and love-filled living.

Prayer Points

Praise God that he has provided us with our greatest need in Jesus and his coming kingdom, and that because of this we do not need to be anxious about our life and our body. Give thanks for the anxieties that God gives to us that help us to grow closer to him and grow in love for others. Ask that God might take away the anxieties of our hearts that draw us away from needing God and instead rely on ourselves. Pray that God's provision would compel us to seek first his kingdom and his righteousness.

Pray for God to expose the hypocrisy of our hearts so that we might grow in humility and discernment. Ask for a deep self-awareness to recognise and confess our own sin before we seek to judge and restore others to holiness. Ask our Father in heaven for the good gifts of forgiveness, righteousness, and wisdom that enable us to live right with God and love our neighbour.

Pray for the Clay Grow Groups as they gather as young workers to sit under God's Word and encourage one another in love and faithful witness. Give thanks that more have joined the community this year, and pray for the community to grow closer to God and each other. Give thanks for the provision of new Grow Leaders to serve the growing numbers, and pray that the existing leaders would be refreshed and spurred on to continue faithfully serving those under their care. Pray that God would use the ministry of Clay to encourage and challenge workers to submit to Jesus as Lord and bear witness to the gospel.

Pray for the final preparations of SaLT

Camp. Pray for Steve as he finishes his Bible teaching sessions, for the leaders as they finalise plans, and for the campers as they prepare to sit under God's Word and share deep fellowship with one another.

Give thanks for the provision of a venue for the Centenary Evangelical Church all-in celebration. Praise God for his timely answer to prayers, and for his sustaining grace in upholding all the churches involved in planting CEC a year ago. Pray that the celebration would be a great opportunity to give praise to God who desires more people to hear the gospel and be welcomed into his kingdom.
