A Better Salvation

Jesus is our better salvation because he saves us from both the penalty and the power of sin, enabling us to fulfil God's intended purpose for humanity.

Prayer Points

Praise God that he is a God who speaks -

Praise God that this is received by faith alone — and praise God that the death of Jesus not only destroys the penalty of sin but also takes away the power of sin. Pray that God would guard us from drifting from such a great salvation

Pray for wisdom and discernment to know how to speak and what to say in the face of offence and disparagement. Pray for ourselves to grow in these same ways.
