

A Better Covenant

Jesus is the minister of a better covenant which promises perfect relationship with God.

Prayer Points

Praise God for the news that Jesus is a priest after the order of Melchizedek! Thank God that he has made a way for his Son to be both King AND High Priest – that he not only sovereignly rule over all creation but he is also the one who draws near to us. Pray that we would be drawn closer to Jesus as well – that we would not be afraid or be more enamoured by the things of this world. Pray that we would find our security in life, personal significance, and comfort in drawing near to Jesus. Pray that our identity and hopes become more deeply rooted in knowing and following Jesus.

Pray for God's Word to keep penetrating our hearts as it first engages our minds. Pray that His Word will not remain something that is simply known in our minds but is also deeply cherished in our hearts. Pray for God's Word to revive in our hearts, perhaps long-dormant desires to live faithfully for him. Pray for the Spirit to take what we hear to burn in our hearts and empower us to live for Him joyfully. Pray for ongoing wisdom and maturity as we seek to discern God's Word in our lives and encourage each other.

Today is World Suicide Prevention Day. Pray that God will work in us to love and care for each other. Pray especially for men, who often find it difficult to share their emotions and tend to suffer alone. Pray that our friendships will grow to become safer places of openness, transparency, and care. Pray for humility, that our hearts will not be so proud to hide our fears and weaknesses. Pray for a love that genuinely seeks out each other's good.

Pray for each other's mental health in general. Pray that we would grow in listening to each other – that this simple act of care would be fruitful and beneficial to many. Ask that God would sustain us as we head towards the end of the year. Pray that God would graciously help us love and serve each other and our families well. Pray that we would find nourishment and healing through our prayer and time in the Word.
