

The Christian life is hard, rife with obstacles, difficulties and suffering. How are we going to make it to the end? Hebrews 11 teaches us to learn from the "Hall of Faith", the greats of the Old Testament that spur us on to run the race of the life of faith until the end.

Prayer Points
