

Prayer Points

Praise God for the resurrection of Jesus!

Praise God that Jesus is truly alive, raised and seated at His right hand, reigning forevermore! Praise God that the resurrection guarantees the death of death, and that those who believe and follow Jesus may die but will also live eternally.

Praise God for the grief we see in Jesus.

Let us be thankful that our God, and our brother, is the man of sorrows and well acquainted with grief. Let's be thankful that his experience of grief reminds us that he truly knows our own griefs, and he truly cares about them. Let us be comforted to know that in Jesus we have a saviour who knows us intimately, loves us, and cares for us.

Pray for those grieving in our midst.

Pray for comfort in knowing Jesus - to know his death and resurrection, and the comfort of knowing the man of sorrows is with them. Pray that the hope of resurrection anchors their present grief and sorrow. Pray for our church to gather around those grieving, to weep with them, to encourage them with our presence, and to encourage those grieving to not give up, but to keep running the race together.

Pray for the Queensland Election that took place yesterday.

Pray that the elected government will govern well, for the benefit of all Queenslanders. Pray that they may govern wisely so that everyone, especially believers, can lead peaceful and quiet lives (cf 1 Timothy 2:1-2). Pray that the great needs of our state will be met with wisdom from our leaders. Pray especially that they would grow in concern for the unborn - to see their lives as precious and valuable, and to defend them legislatively.

Pray for the upcoming SLE Church AGM.

Give thanks for the work that He has done among us over the past year. Pray for the election of the new elders and deacons - for wisdom in their election, and that God would use them to represent and serve our community well. Pray for ongoing wisdom for the Council as they seek to serve and lead our church. Pray for the proposed budget, that God would be at work in us to be generous and through the budget to grow his kingdom and build his glory.
