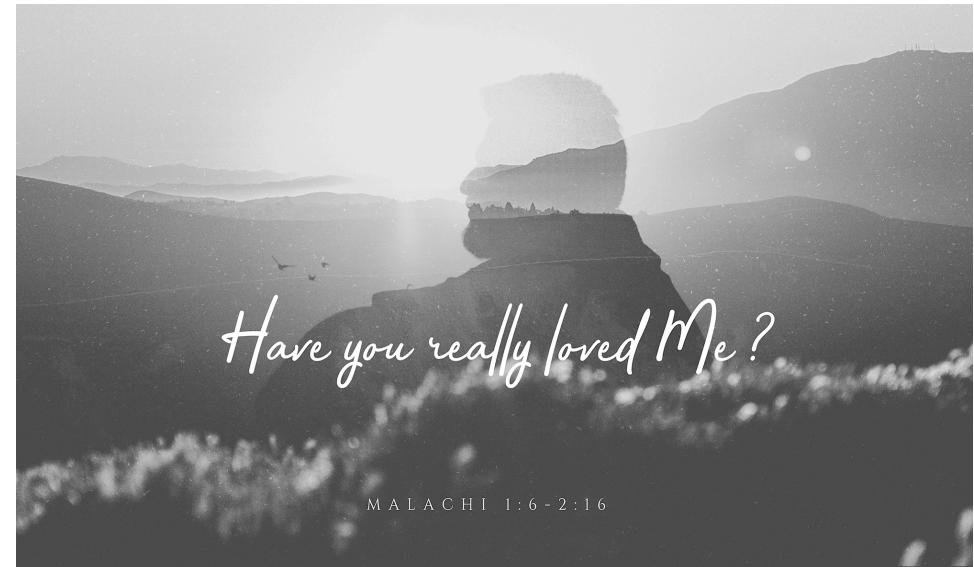

Have you really loved Me?

The people of God are rebuked for their faithlessness in which they despise worship and God's marriage covenants.

Prayer Points

Praise God that His love for us is clearly demonstrated in the defeat of our enemies – spiritual forces and principalities, and more deeply, our sin.

Thank God that His love is not dependent on what we are like or what we do, but on His promise of steadfast love. He loves us with the deep and unwavering affection of a Father. We can be confident of our Father's love for us because He sent His Son to disarm the spiritual powers and principalities (Col 2:15), and ultimately, to defeat our sin. Whoever believes in the Son will receive the Father's love and the incomparable gift of eternal life with Him – may God be praised for making this possible!

Pray that in our weariness, we would be refreshed in God's love and not give in to doubts of his love for us.

At a time where many of us are physically, emotionally and spiritually weary, ask that God would show us the heart issues hindering us from following Christ wholeheartedly. Where doubts of God's love start to creep in, ask that God would enable us to walk with each other in prayerful and understanding ways, providing safe spaces to engage with hard questions and bring these before God together. Pray that God would be at work to grow our love and affection towards Him as we persevere in engaging with His Word and prayer, even when our feelings try to persuade us away from these acts of worship. Thank God that when we feel weak in the battle to persevere in living out our faith, we can be assured of his unchanging love for us.

Pray for the Primary Kids Church Christmas Party next Sunday.

Thank God for the many friends who are expected to come! Pray that the really good news of Christmas would be communicated in a clear and engaging way, and that the newcomers would not just be attracted to the fun of the day but ultimately to the good news of a King who deals with our biggest problem. Ask that God would grant good weather so that the event can go ahead as planned. As some of the wider church community meets together this Friday for the working bee, pray for the many preparations to come together smoothly. May we all be intentional in praying for Jesus to be magnified through this event and the ensuing interactions that may occur with children and parents.

Pray for the newly elected US President, Donald Trump.

Pray for a peaceful transfer of power as Donald Trump prepares for his second term in office. Pray that he would govern well for the benefit of all, with wisdom, courage and integrity. Ask that God would grow in him the humility to see his sins, the honesty to admit his faults, the grace to forgive his enemies, and the strength of character to change his mind. May God be gracious in working through his governance to bring greater stability to his nation and the world, and compassionate help for the poor and powerless. Pray that Christians would be wise and continue to place our hopes in Jesus' death and resurrection to change our world, rather than in political powers.
