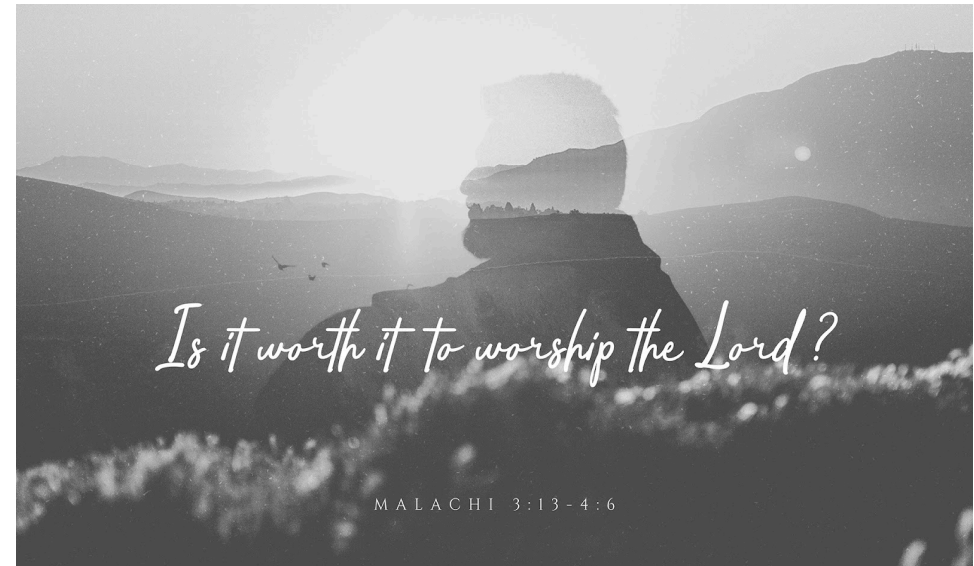

Is it worth it to worship the Lord?

Following Jesus is worth it because when he returns, he will spare us from judgement and free us from sin.

Prayer Points

Praise God that He is the God of justice!

Praise God that His justice is not indefinitely delayed, but that we live in a time of amnesty - a time between the announcement of His impending judgement and the day of that judgement. Praise God that we are not consumed this very moment, but His mercy holds back the coming of his Son and His grace gives everyone a chance to repent. Pray that we would be instruments in His hands to proclaim the gospel to a world awaiting judgement.

Pray for our hearts to be generous in

giving to God. Pray for a deep conviction and understanding of the stewardship we have been given - that all the resources we have (our money, time, and energy) belong to God and are to be used for His good purposes. Pray that we would trust His promise to bless us and provide for us when we give generously to His causes.

Continue praying for the upcoming

Christmas Carols event. Pray that the event organisation will continue to come along smoothly. Pray for the message to be spoken that day, that it would be clear and help unbelievers understand why Jesus is worthy of our devotion and song. Pray for our unbelieving friends and family to take up the opportunity to come to church, sing carols, and hear of the great news of Jesus' coming into this world.

Pray for those living with a disability and their families.

The 3rd December marks the 'International Day of Persons with a Disability'. Praise God for creating all people equally in his image, and that sin and the effects of the Fall do not erase this unshakeable basis of the value of all human life. Thank God for his deep compassion for those who are often forgotten, excluded, and isolated because of their disabilities - we see this modelled in Jesus who intentionally reached out to those on the margins of society. Pray for those wrestling with grief, exhaustion and overwhelm in the face of the societal, relational and practical challenges that disability can bring. Pray that as a church, we would grow in our awareness, understanding, and valuing of people with a disability, so that we can develop an environment where they would find their hope, dignity and place in the body of Christ. We especially ask that God would grow our wisdom to know how to honour those in our church family with a disability, just as he has designed for them to receive the greatest honour in his church body (1 Cor 12:21-25).
