

The Discipline Of Prayer

Prayer trains God's children to depend on their Father and desire his Kingdom.

Prayer Points

Give thanks for God's Word! Give thanks that our God is a God who speaks, reveals himself, and preserves this word for generations. Praise God that His word never comes back empty but accomplishes what he purposes (cf Isaiah 55:11). Praise God that the Spirit takes this word and uses it to give us life. Pray that we would grow in the discipline of receiving God's Word – through daily devotion personally and through prepared and hungry hearts when we gather. Ask that God would grow in us a hunger for his word and an attitude of being easily edified.

Give thanks for those who were baptised last weekend. Pray especially that our church community would be a place that would keep encouraging them and each other to persevere in the gospel. Pray for a growing heart and mindset that seeks to know and pray for each other, to encourage and build each other up, that none of us would fall to the deceitfulness of sin or outlive our love for lesus.

Give thanks for Christmas. Give thanks especially for the coming of Jesus into this world. For the incarnation – that Jesus' came as one who was fully and truly divine and fully and truly human, not a blending of the two but of true unity in his one body – give thanks, because through it the gospel is able to truly work. Give thanks for the wisdom of God's plan in sending Jesus in this way, that we might know Him eternally.

Pray for each other to find good rest over this Christmas period. Pray for those travelling to be safe. Pray especially that our time away from work will be refreshing, and that we would return in 2025 renewed and ready to continue serving. Pray that this period would also help us grow healthy habits of rest, ensuring sustainable and joyful service through 2025 and beyond.
