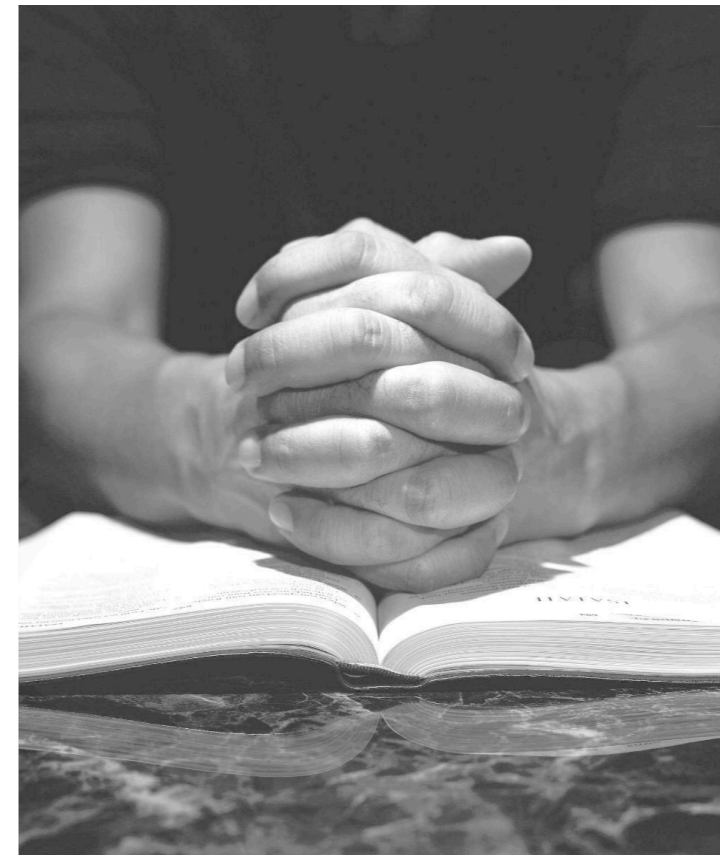

## Everything *We Need*

2 Peter 1:1-11

### Everything We Need

As we seek to follow Jesus together, the Apostle Peter assures us that we have everything we need to live a godly life. But what is this "everything"? How do we receive it? And what does it look like in the day to day realities of life? This Sunday, Pastor Greg Gardiner will unpack the beginning of Peter's second letter, equipping us to live out our faith in Jesus through all the promises He has made us.

## Prayer Points

---

**Praise God that he is our everything in life and death.** Pray that as we embark on a new year that we would not seek goodness apart from God, but instead find refuge in his presence in which there is fullness of joy. Pray that we would not put our trust in other things that will only lead us to suffering, but instead cling to Jesus who is our eternal hope.

**Pray for assurance to know that God has graciously given us everything we need to live a godly life.** Give thanks for his precious and great promises which he has given to us through faith in Jesus Christ. Pray that we would continue to spur one another on towards love and godliness.

**Pray for all those involved in the upcoming Taste & See dinners.** Give thanks for those willing to host, cook, and present so that many have the opportunity to hear the gospel and believe. Thank God for the deep connections and friendships that He has already given many families and older adults in our church. Pray for opportunity and winsomeness as we seek to invite them along to Taste & See.

**Pray for the US government in their transition to new leadership.** Pray that God would grant them wisdom and ability to uphold their duty to serve their people. Ask that God would protect them from corruption and the temptation to serve themselves.

**Give thanks for the work of the gospel in Australia.** Praise God for the Christians who brought the Christian faith onto our shores, who lived faithfully, loved their neighbours, planted churches, and worked for gospel growth in their own generation and for generations to come. Praise God for bringing the nations to our shores so that they might have the opportunity to hear the gospel, grow in their faith, and take the gospel back to their home countries. Pray that God would have mercy on all those who call Australia home, and that he would teach us to trust in his Son Jesus as our Lord and Saviour.
