Jesus Confronts the Need for Workers

Out of compassion Jesus sends workers to proclaim his gospel to the lost and assures them that though they will be persecuted, God will provide for them.

Prayer Points

Monday: Praise God for the opportunity to grow deep in the Word through our bible study series in Romans. For helping us understand the urgency of the gospel, the depths of our denial of God as creator, and the richness of the truth found in our justification through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Ask that we will not grow complacent and hard-hearted from thinking that we already know these truths, but for God to grow our humility in upholding the Bible as God's spoken word to us, his children.

Tuesday: Give thanks to God that we can freely run to him in our desperation.

Through our sermon series in Matthew, we have been reminded that we can rest and be assured that he will freely receive us since we are already reconciled to God and have been given new life to worship and love our Creator. We pray that we may turn to him daily and grow our thanksgiving for all that he is and all that he has done, rejoicing in our close relationship with the Almighty God.

Wednesday: Ask that God may continue to grow our love for one another. That we may prioritise spending time with each other in community, praying for one another, and serving each other. To remember that God created us to love him and love each other. Ask that God will help us see past our differences in culture, background, and stage of life. And model to one another and those outside the church a love that exists only because of our union with Jesus.

Thursday: Thank God for all the faithful volunteers in both formal and informal areas of ministry. From the childminders and people who volunteer to drive others around, to the kids' church teachers and host team members. Thank God for the servant-heartedness shown to one another, living as Jesus lived in sacrificial service.

Friday: Praise God for the many opportunities to preach the good news of

Jesus! Through the Kids Church Easter events, Life Course, Taste & See, and Mamak for Mission. For growing in our hearts Jesus' compassion for the lost and a boldness to preach the goodness of Jesus. Pray for the ongoing evangelism efforts of our members from these events and beyond, that the non-Christians hearing the gospel may have soft hearts and come to one day believe in Jesus for themselves.

Saturday: Pray for Gracepoint Evangelical Church, PJ, Malaysia. For the senior pastor Mike and his wife, Eunice to be sustained amidst sleep deprivation and demands of caring for newborn Jordan. Pastorally, for Mike to have patience in teaching bible to the congregation and God to use him well in campus ministry. Give thanks for 60+ people coming every Sunday, 2 new believers, more non-Christians showing up to evangelistic events than regulars, their core team serving with joy. Ask for conviction and provision of 2 new ministry apprentices and 1 staff worker next year. Pray also for their church camp and the talks by the speaker Wally. Pray also for Malaysians' gospel openness: for the Holy spirit to work in the hearts of the country and continued willingness of the congregation to invite people to church on Easter and beyond.
