

The Triumph Of Love

Jesus' resurrection assures us that nothing will ever separate us from God and his love.

Prayer Points

Monday: Praise God that Christ is risen!

Give thanks for the sure hope we have in the resurrection of Jesus Christ, especially as we continue to face hardship and suffering in our present lives, and as we mourn the ongoing impact of sin and death. Pray that the resurrection would continue to assure us that God's love for us can never be taken away while we cling to Jesus in faith.

Tuesday: Give thanks for the baptisms held and the opportunity to celebrate new life

in Christ. Give thanks for the way God has graciously worked in the lives of those baptised to bring them to faith and salvation in Jesus. Pray that God would use them to proclaim and bear witness to his gospel. Pray that as a church we would continue to celebrate when Jesus welcomes even one of his lost sheep home, and pray that Jesus would send more workers to proclaim his gospel.

Wednesday: Give thanks for the godly and humble men and women who serve on the

Church Council. Pray for wisdom and discernment as they meet to discuss and make decisions about the strategy and direction of our church. Pray especially for good stewardship of the finances and resources God has given through his people to the church. Pray that these decisions would lead to faithful and fruitful proclamation of the gospel.

Thursday: Pray for those who struggle to feel assured of God's love, whether they are exploring Christianity or they are struggling in their faith. Pray that the reminder of Easter Sunday and the reality of Jesus' resurrection would demonstrate how God's love is so much greater than anything this world can offer, and that nothing in this world can separate us from this love. Pray for those exploring to know this love for themselves, and for those struggling to remember the depths of this love.

Friday: Give thanks for God's work in

Anchor Church Melbourne who last month celebrated one year of gospel ministry in the West of Melbourne. Pray for Pastor Quan and the rest of the core team as they lead their church into a second year of preaching the gospel. Pray that many people, particularly the Vietnamese and Asian-Australians who live in the West of Melbourne, would embrace the gospel of Jesus as their only hope for a better life. Pray that Anchor Church would grow to be as culturally diverse as the people around them, and that God would use these people to spread the hope of Jesus to people in Melbourne and beyond.
