Jesus Confronts Expectations

Whatever our expectations, we receive Jesus as he is, not as we imagine him to be.

Prayer Points

Monday: Give thanks to God for our mothers—for the women who gave us birth or adopted us and raised us and cared for us. Give thanks also for our spiritual mothers, for the women who pray for us and minister to us and nurture us spiritually. Pray for those who struggle through the grief of having lost their mothers or are estranged from their mothers that God might give them comfort. Pray that as a church we would lament with those who struggle as mothers, or long to be mothers, or who as mothers have lost children too soon, and ask that God would comfort and heal.

Tuesday: Praise God that we can have comfort through our identity in Christ. Pray that when we are tempted to seek our identity in our personalities, our relationships, our work, our achievements, etc. we would remember our core identity as those who are in Christ and therefore sons of God and slaves of God. Give thanks for the many Bloom home gatherings last weekend and for the fellowship between women from all across our church. Pray for the women in our church to continue in encouraging and supporting one another in their walk as disciples of Jesus.

Wednesday: Pray for the elders of SLE Church—Mike, Daniel, Randy, Jacky, Steven, and Richard as they lead and shepherd our church. Pray that they would be above reproach, watching their life and doctrine closely. Pray that they would discharge their duties to care for the spiritual well-being of the people in our church faithfully. Pray that God would give the elders wisdom as they consider matters of teaching and doctrine within our church.

Thursday: Praise God for giving us his only Son to be for us both a sacrifice for sin and an example of godly life. Pray that God would give us grace to always be thankful for his costly sacrifice, and to also daily strive to take up our cross and follow him.

Friday: Pray for our Grow Groups as they resume meeting this term. Pray that in these groups, the word of Christ would dwell richly within and among us, deepening our trust, dependence, and assurance in God. Pray for these groups to be a space for people to grow in maturity and care for one another. Pray that as our groups continue through the book of Romans that people would marvel at the gospel of salvation and give thanks to God for his gracious love in Jesus' death and resurrection.

Saturday: Pray for friends coming along to Primary Kids Church Bring A Friend Day.
