

Steadfast In Faith

The church can remain steadfast in faith amidst persecution because relief and glory await when Jesus returns to establish his kingdom.

Prayer Points

Monday: Give thanks for our Matthew sermon series. Give thanks to God for such a great time to slow down in Matthew’s gospel and really see the heart and soul of our Lord Jesus.

Spend some time reflecting on how God’s word has been challenging or encouraging you through our Matthew sermon series.

Tuesday: Pray for the escalating conflict between Israel and Iran. Pray that God would comfort those injured and grieving in Iran and Israel. That God would restrain the hands of violence, give wisdom to leaders and protect the innocent. And pray that God’s mercy would break through the chaos. We pray for an immediate ceasefire, healing for the wounded civilians, and divine restraint over further military escalation between Israel and Iran.

Wednesday: Thank God for the end of assessments for many of our students. Give thanks to God for sustaining the students at SLE through their assessment periods. Thank God for the gift of education and learning, and pray that the things they have learnt will be used to bless those they serve and work for in the future. Pray that God would give them rest during their holidays, that they would spend time enjoying God and his creation.

Thursday: The Lord’s Prayer. Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For yours is the kingdom and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

Friday: Pray for a hunger for the Bible. Pray that our church would be filled with people who hunger for hearing from God in their private devotions, public gatherings, and conversations with other believers. Ask God to give us an abiding delight in his Word. Ask God to cause us hunger for the truth while being ever satisfied with the truth.

Saturday: Prayer of Confession. Heavenly Father, you made us for your glory, redeemed us by your Son, and sealed us with your Spirit. We grieve today for the many expressions of our self-centeredness. We are self-loving; self-serving; self-protecting; self-righteous; and self-interested. By your grace, forgive our sin and conquer our selfishness. Establish your Son as the king of our hearts and the center of our lives. Amen.
