Steadfast in Mission

The church needs to remain steadfast in their mission to proclaim the gospel so that more people will put their trust in Jesus.

Prayer Points

Father for his mercy and grace in sending
Jesus his only son. Having delivered us from
the domain of darkness and into the kingdom of
Christ, in whom we have redemption, the
forgiveness of sins. Ask that God may continue
to fill us with the knowledge of his will, that we
may be filled in spiritual wisdom and
understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy
and pleasing to our Lord.

Tuesday: Ask that God may continue to strengthen our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus as we sit under 2 Thessalonians. That we may stand firm and be assured, not by our works, nor easily shaken by false teachings, but rooted in the free gospel of Jesus and hold firm to living out a life pleasing to him. Having full assurance because Christ is steadfast and able to guard us.

Wednesday: Pray for The Crossing Church in Singapore. Give thanks for their continuous growth in maturity as a church. Keep them in prayer as they endeavour to plant more gospel-centred churches in Singapore and beyond. Praise God also for our ongoing partnership with the many graduates that have found a new church family with them over the past few years. We ask that God will continue sustain these ex-SLE attendees in their counter cultural living for Jesus.

Thursday: Pray for those affected by the heavy rainfall and damaging winds in New South Wales. That recovery efforts will be smooth for those facing property damage, displacement, and hardship. Pray that churches in affected areas will be a source of help and hope, pointing others to the gospel as they extend a hand in providing practical help.

Friday: Pray that God will show mercy to those experiencing unrest around the

world. Bring before Him the families and children who have been exploited or had their trust violated—ask for justice and protection. Pray for those affected by the recent Bali ferry accident, for those caught in the ongoing conflict in the Gaza region, and for communities experiencing civil unrest in the United States. In the face of such widespread brokenness, ask that many would recognise the depth of human need and turn to Christ, the One who hears our cries and offers true and lasting hope.

Saturday: Pray for the potential newcomers and explorers of Christianity.

As our church prepares to welcome newcomers in the coming months, they will feel welcomed into our home and experience the depth and warmth of being part of God's family. Ask that newcomers will be eager to call this place their home as they explore Christianity or find a place to sit under God's word and be in community with God's people.
