

Steadfast In Work

The church is commanded to remain steadfast in work so that we keep loving one another while we wait for Jesus to return.

Prayer Points

Monday: God is faithful! Therefore, we can be confident in the Lord because of His faithfulness as we do what He commands us to do. Praise God that we are called to be on the same mission that God sent His Son Jesus to do-proclaim His Kingdom come. Praise God that as we carry out His mission, we can trust that His Spirit would open hearts toward trusting in His gospel.

Tuesday: Forgive us for doing God's work as if it solely depends on our efforts. We

see this in how we rush headlong into planning and executing work without coming to God in prayer. Grow us to delight in depending on His strength and wisdom to do His work. Open our eyes to see God's power at work—in us, and in those we minister to-as we serve.

Wednesday: Open our eyes and hearts to see that God's mission is for the whole

world. As we read news and scroll through social media, queue up for things and go about our lives, open our eyes to see the sobering reality-that without Christ, our world is hurtling headlong towards eternal separation from Him. Stir our hearts to cry out to God for more time for our world to repent, and for the Lord of the harvest to send out more workers.

Thursday: Pray for ourselves, and each other, that we would be faithful followers

of Jesus. That we would seek to live, serve, and to be ministers of the gospel-whether in formal or informal ways. Ask God to help us live out our gospel-shaped identity in whatever role and responsibility He has entrusted to us, so that the fragrance of Christ might linger in our words and actions.

Friday: Pray for the various team trainings and gatherings that have taken place or are happening. Pray that each team would desire to grow as members of the body of Christ—learning to live and serve in unity. May God mature them to support one another in healthy, gospel-shaped ways. Guide them with wisdom and creativity, that they might use their giftings, skills and experiences to serve faithfully. May all that they co-labour in be done for God's glory and for the flourishing of His church.

Saturday: Pray for the winter season—particularly those vulnerable to

illness. Ask for God's protection, and for His healing hand upon those needing recovery. Intercede for those struggling in body, mind, or spirit—that each would be comforted by the assurance of God's ever-present care and their secure belonging in Him.

Praise God for the love and care within our church family, which reflects the love that Christ has for us.

And pray for us, that we would notice those who are absent from among us. May we pause, reach out, and extend the compassion of Christ to one another.
