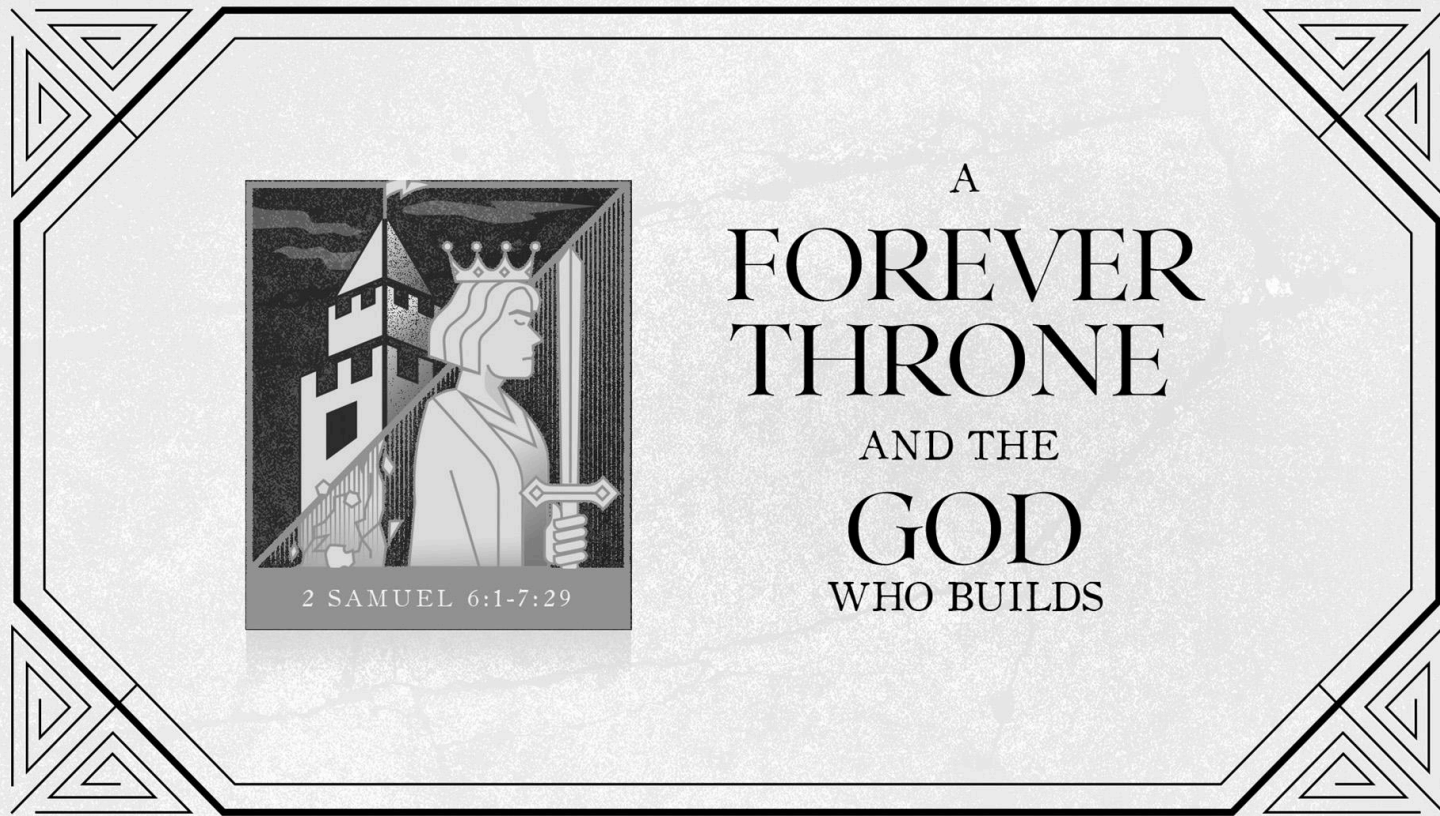

Prayer Points
