

The King Who Rules With Justice And Mercy

God's King rules with justice, righteousness, mercy and steadfast love—making us long for the days of this to come.

Prayer Points

Monday: Praise God our Heavenly Father for adopting us as his children and making us heirs of eternal life. Give thanks for his mercy in washing us from our sins and making us clean in his sight. Ask God to forgive us for our sins and failing to love and serve him as we should. Ask God to renew us by his grace so that we may continue to grow as God's house in Jesus.

Tuesday: Give thanks for the generosity of those who give financially to the ministry of SLE Church.
