

The Fall That Echoes In Every Heart

God's king takes what is not his and brings God's judgement on himself and his house.

Prayer Points

Monday: Praise God for the just, righteous, merciful, and steadfast loving rule of Jesus — the true King we all need and long for. Thank God that His reign is unshaken even in times of sorrow and uncertainty. **Pray for Aunty Yin-Leng**, asking that, if it is His will, God would graciously bring healing. Above all, pray that Yin-Leng and her family would keep trusting His sovereign goodness, whatever the outcome, and that the peace Christ secured at the cross would guard their hearts and minds in Him.

Tuesday: Give thanks for the opportunity to proclaim the gospel at our PKC Bring a Friend day. Pray that the good news of Jesus would draw the hearts of each child and family to put their faith in Jesus. Pray that our church would be a warm and welcoming community for those who are exploring Jesus or who have recently put their faith in him.

Wednesday: Pray for Vine Church in Yarrabilba as they seek to be a community centred on Jesus finding life, hope, and purpose in him. Pray for their official launch at the end of this month as they seek to grow together, meet people in the community, and see God at work with his gospel mission. Pray for the people moving into Yarrabilba, that as they seek the hope, community, and fresh start this new suburb offers, they would find that this can only be fully realised in relationship with Jesus. Pray that the fruit of the gospel would flourish in Yarrabilba as more people depend upon Jesus for life, hope, and mission.

Thursday: Pray to the Lord of the harvest, that he might send more workers into the fields to proclaim the good news of Jesus.

Pray for more men and women to offer themselves up to be trained for gospel ministry in churches, at uni campuses, and in cross-cultural mission. Pray that the Queensland Theological College Open Week and the upcoming SPUR Conference would provide opportunities for men and women to be inspired, challenged, and raised up to be the next generation of gospel workers.

Friday: Pray to our loving God for those who are hurting or lonely, through bereavement, relationship breakdown, or abuse, and for those struggling with unhappiness in singleness and marriage. Pray that where repentance is needed, make us humble and willing, where justice is needed, make us fair and righteous, and where reconciliation is needed, make us eager to forgive as we have been forgiven in Christ. Pray that God would be our strength and comfort in every difficulty and struggle.

Saturday: Pray that we would be a church that takes sin seriously—not covering or minimising it—but bringing it into the light, receiving God's mercy, and reflecting His grace to one another. Pray that we would be a church that resists the ways of this world: where leaders and people often take for their own gain. Ask God to shape us into a community marked by giving—our time, our care, our forgiveness—and not taking, so as to reflect the character of our Servant King who gave His life so that we might live.
