Prayer Points

Monday: Give thanks to God for being our rock, our fortress, our deliverer, our shield, our salvation, our stronghold, our refuge, and our saviour. Praise God that he is our salvation and our refuge, promising great salvation through Jesus whom he delivered from death to rescue us from sin. Praise God that he has been constantly at work in the lives of his people, bringing them to salvation through the gospel and growing them in their trust and dependence on Jesus their king.

Tuesday: Give thanks for the ministry of Primary Kids Church in discipling the children at church to know, grow and follow Jesus the king. Give thanks for the book of Ecclesiastes that they went through last term. Ask that the kids would remember how big and eternal God is compared with how small and fleeting this world is. Pray that the teachers would be role models who live not for worldly endeavours but live in proper fear of God. Pray that God might grant the kids church team good rest over the break and continue to raise up more servants who love children and love God.

Wednesday: Praise God for his heart to save the lost and bring people into his kingdom through the gospel of Jesus. Pray for ongoing wisdom and discernment for the church leaders as they continue to make plans to grow and multiply our church so that more people would respond to the gospel and come under the rule of Jesus. Pray that as we grow in number, we would also grow in maturity, living as disciples who are captivated by Jesus and transformed by his gospel.

Thursday: Give thanks for our Grow Leaders who serve joyfully and sacrificially in leading their Grow Groups to see people grow as mature disciples of Jesus. Pray for them to keep developing as leaders of God's people as they guide their groups to let the word of Christ dwell among them richly. Pray that they would continue to treasure God's Word for themselves and to model living out God's Word in their own lives for their group members. Ask that God would enable them to pastor and care for their people, and to encourage them to pastor and care for one another.

Friday: Pray for our sister church Huai En Tang (HET) as they proclaim the gospel to the Chinese-speaking people in our area. Give thanks to God for their growth as a church, both in welcoming new people and in their maturity as disciples of Jesus. Pray for their Senior Pastor Kia Teck Tan as he leads and shepherds the church. Pray that God might grant them wisdom and discernment as they consider plans for a second service to reach Chinese-speaking students. Pray that God might continue to strengthen our partnership with HET as we support one another in our mission to reach Brisbane with the gospel of Jesus.

Saturday: Give thanks for the soft launch this Sunday of Orange Evangelical Church City, a new congregation plant in Orange, NSW. Give thanks for the provision of a good community space in the PCYC building to meet weekly. Give thanks for the launch team of 33 adults and 35 kids who desire to see this part of the city reached with the gospel. Ask that God might sustain and energise Nathan Millham as he leads the church plant team and preaches on Grace this Sunday.
