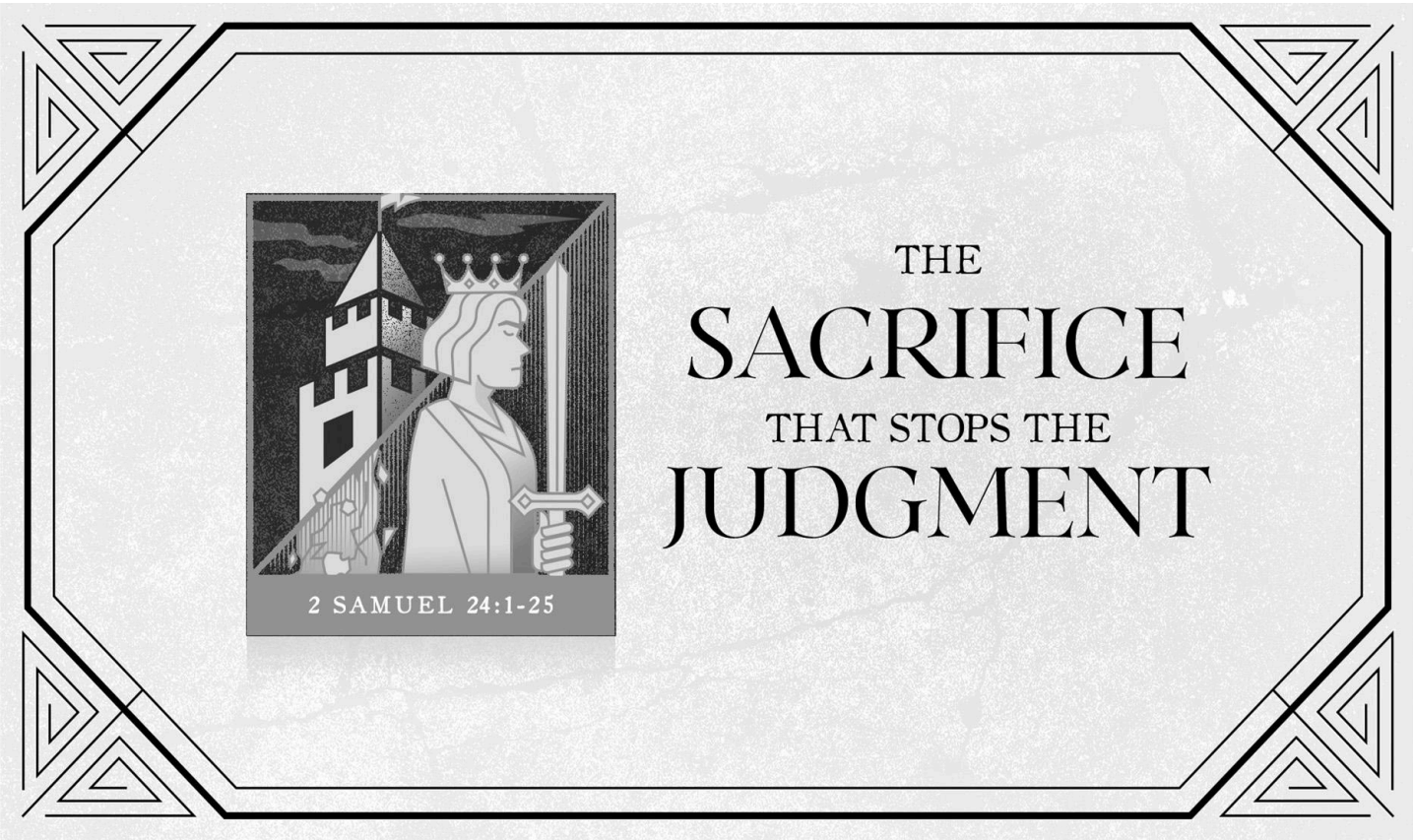

The Sacrifice that Stops the Judgment

God shows mercy to his true but imperfect king so that he can show us mercy through his true and perfect king.

Prayer Points

Monday: Praise God for choosing his rightful ruler, Jesus. Ask that God may continue to work in our hearts by showing us all the ways in which we are tempted to follow everything else in futility. That we may continuously repent and turn toward Jesus, God’s chosen ruler, and dedicate our whole lives to making him known.

Tuesday: Pray for rest and ongoing dependence on God for strength. As the year comes to an end in 3 months, ask that God may give us opportunities to rest, reflect, and continually rely on Him for strength. It is often far too easy for us to rely on ourselves and fill ourselves up with worries and anxieties of the things outside of our control. Ask for God’s help to help us rest in Him and in the work that he does through our weaknesses.

Wednesday: Pray for the young people returning to a new school term. Praise God for the opportunity to work for him in school and/or at university. Ask that as they learn more about the world, that their love for God may only abound. Pray for more opportunities to praise God and preach the good news of Jesus in whatever circumstance they may be in.

Thursday: Pray for those within our family who have experienced death recently. Pray for Elder Daniel Tan and his wife Lin as they grieve the loss of Lin’s father who went home peacefully to be with his Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ on Wednesday evening. Pray for their family and particularly for Lin’s mother as they work through their grief. Give thanks for the good news of Jesus and the hope of the resurrection, and pray that this hope would bring comfort to their grief. Pray that as a church we would mourn with those who mourn while together lifting our eyes to Jesus who is our only source of hope and salvation.

Friday: Pray for churches that we partner with. Anchor Church is the church plant from Laneway Church. We’ve been partnering with them through financial support. This weekend a group of 37 from their church will be heading to a church camp, hearing from the book of Jonah. Pray for the campers to travel home safely, and that the big lessons of God’s far-reaching mercy would be embraced. Pray that it’ll keep pushing them on mission to love and include newcomers and outsiders to their church.

Saturday: Pray for the World around us. As the world continues to suffer under the effects of sin, ask that God may be merciful and provide not only practical aid, but the greatest solution to the brokenness of the world: Jesus. Pray for Christians all around the world to shine bright the illuminating and life-giving rule of Christ.
