Hope In The Resurrection

The resurrection of Jesus disrupts reality, causing alarm to those who deny him and give hope to those who trust him.

Prayer Points

Monday - Pray Through Acts 24.

Pray that our hopes for the present and future, following Paul's example, would be deeply rooted in the resurrection of Jesus. Pray that this resurrection hope would wonderfully disrupt our reality, causing us to radically live out the gospel and proclaim it's reality to friends and family. Pray that though it may alarm some, that it would also bring salvation and blessed comfort to others.

Tuesday - AGM and Membership

Pray for the members of our church to take up what was covered in the recent Annual General Meeting – that members would take up their responsibilities to love deeply, care widely, and give and serve generously. Pray that more people within our church would grasp the rich privileges and responsibility of membership, and choose to commit to SLE Church in this important way.

Wednesday - Safety During Storm Season

Storm season has well and truly begun in Brisbane/South-East Queensland. Give thanks that damage was not severe for the members of our church. Pray for safety and protection against further damage, and pray for generosity towards our neighbours who may be more severely affected.

Thursday - For Families

Pray for families to experience God's grace in both the busyness and the beauty of everyday life. Ask that parents would lead with gentleness, that children would grow in love for Christ, and that family time would strengthen rather than strain their faith. Pray that each home would be a small picture of the gospel – full of forgiveness, laughter, and trust in God's provision.

Friday - For Singles

Pray that singles in our church would thrive in wholehearted devotion to Christ and rich connection within His people. Ask that their friendships and fellowship would be marked by depth, joy, and mutual encouragement. Pray that they would use their time, energy, and gifts with purpose – serving others, growing in maturity, and investing in God's kingdom with freedom and faith. Give thanks that every season of life offers unique opportunities to display the goodness of belonging to Jesus.

Saturday - For Students

Pray for students entering exams. Not only for focus and energy to sustain them, but also that they would continue to prioritise gathering and fellowship in this busy and stressful period. Pray that students would delight in both their studies and their fellowship, seeing each as part of God's good purposes. Ask that their gatherings would be rich in encouragement and help them see their studies within the larger story of God's gospel work.
