Gospel Integrity

Even the scheming and impotence of human power serve God's providential purposes—giving us confidence and a call to integrity in patience.

Prayer Points

Monday - Acts 25

Praise God that He is sovereign and always providentially working all things for the good of those who love Him. Praise God that even when things are not going our way - when life feels stalled, busyness overwhelms, or when it feels like life is chaotic - God is still at work. Pray that we would trust His good hand over everything, and pray that we would live in the moment with faithfulness and gospel-integrity.

Tuesday - Give thanks for Royce & Sarah's Wedding.

Praise God for bringing them together as one. Ask God to be growing them in their love for Him and each other in their marriage, that God would give them wisdom as Royce seeks to lovingly lead, and Sarah seeks to submit. May God be at work with their friends who do not yet know Christ as their Lord—that they would grow with curious interest in seeing how central it is for Royce and Sarah to put God first in their marriage, and so, open a doorway to sharing the gospel..

Wednesday - Pray for those in the Philippines affected by Typhoon Kalmaegi.

May God comfort the many who have lost loved ones, or are missing. Ask that the cleanup would run smoothly, that people would be able to return to their homes. That even through this devastation, God would be working through the Christian community in the area to love those in need, and that there might be opportunities to present the good news of Christ.

Thursday - Give thanks for those who attended Newcomers Lunch.

Give thanks that six people recently attended our New Comers Lunch. Give thanks that we regularly have new people visiting SLE. Ask God to help us welcome them well into our community through the various events we run throughout the week to enable them to become mature disciples of Jesus, investing in the next generations.

Friday - Pray for Pastor Richard and Kevin (and their group) as they travel.

Ask God that they'd have a safe and restful time away. Ask that their time away with a group would be fruitful in growing as brothers and sisters in Christ, and that they would be able to enjoy exploring God's amazing creation, and return refreshed.

Saturday - Ask God to grow us as a community investing in the next generations.

Pray that our hearts might reflect the love that Jesus' heart has for the lost. Ask that we'd be including, welcoming and loving the younger generation, working on communicating well to grow them in their understanding and love for Jesus.
