
Prayer Points

Monday - Acts 27:1-28:10

Praise God for His sovereign providence which preserved Paul through storms, shipwreck, and snakebites to continue His mission. Give thanks for the reassurance that He rules the storm and fulfils His Word. Pray that we would be strengthened in our confidence to trust Him and remain faithfully on mission. Pray that we would grow in trusting His timing in all situations and circumstances of our own lives.

Tuesday - Primary Kids Church Christmas Party

Give thanks for the PKC Christmas Party that happened on Sunday. Praise God that 70+ kids registered, including 14 first time visitors, making a total of 30+ friends invited! Pray that they would know God's love for themselves. Ask God to be working in the hearts of the kids who haven't yet trusted and believed in Jesus as their saviour. Pray that the team's followup would be effective in welcoming them into our community, and effectively presenting the Good News to them.

Wednesday - St Lucia Bible Church as Roy Davidson is retiring from Senior Pastor in mid 2026

Give thanks for Roy's faithful service to SLBC over the past few decades as Senior Pastor. Ask God to be working in him as he decides how best to serve the church going forward in a new chapter of life. Ask God to give the selection committee wisdom as they search for a suitable person to take over leading SLBC from mid 2026. Ask that they'd be able to find the right person in a timely manner, so they can continue growing as a community of disciples of Christ, raising others up to serve Him.

Thursday - For those who are suffering

Ask God to be close to those within our church family who are suffering, heavy laden and struggling. Give thanks for Jesus' gentle and lowly heart, a yoke which is easy and a burden which is light. Ask God to be growing us as a community of disciples of Jesus who remind each other of these truths, and sacrificially support each other through times of difficulty.

Friday - Junior Kids Church Christmas Party

Praise God for his warm love for kids as the perfect father, and pray that through the JKC Christmas Party, more kids would know and believe this for themselves. Ask God to help the team communicate in truth and love, in a way that's clear and easy to understand for the kids. Pray that the event would be well attended, and those considering would come along. Ask God to provide good weather which enables families to attend easily.

Saturday - FIEC

Give thanks to God for the Fellowship of Independent Evangelical Churches (FIEC) for their guidance and encouragement that they've provided to SLE. During this time of unfair public scrutiny, ask God to help the leadership team have wisdom and grace in interacting with the media. Pray that their defence would be a testament to the incredible grace that has been given to us. Ask God to be working through FIEC to spread his good news, even in the face of unfair opposition.
