

Proclaiming With All Boldness

At long last, we reach the end of our journey through the book of Acts as Paul finally arrives in the great city of Rome. But why does Luke end the story so abruptly? This week, we explore how the final chapter reveals a gospel that is vindicated, resisted, and yet continues to advance without hindrance.

Prayer Points

Monday: Pray in response to God's Word.

Praise God for speaking to us through Acts 21–28. Give thanks for the certainty we can have that the gospel truly is God's unchanging plan to establish his kingdom amongst all peoples. Give thanks for his divine providence throughout history and up till today, bringing the gospel of Jesus to more and more people so that they can repent, believe, and be saved. Pray that as beneficiaries of this gospel that we would get on board with God's ongoing and unstoppable mission by proclaiming the gospel with all boldness.

Tuesday: Give thanks for Grow Groups.

Give thanks to God for the opportunity to grow in maturity in Grow Groups this year. Give thanks for the 338 different people who came along to sit under the richness of God's Word in the Bible and enjoy warm fellowship with others in order to grow deeper in maturity. Give thanks for the 60 Grow Leaders who serve by leading and loving and praying for the people in these Grow Groups as they continue to live as disciples of Jesus. Pray that God would continue to work in his Word, by his Spirit, and through his people to grow and transform people in godliness.

Wednesday: Give thanks for the marriage of Boonito and Wendy.

Give thanks to the God of love for giving us the gift of marriage. Give thanks for the joining in marriage of Wendy and Boonito on Saturday. Pray that they would know God's presence in their joys and in their sorrows, and ask God to deepen their love for each other and sustain them in their commitment and vows. Pray that their marriage would proclaim the love of Jesus to those around them.

Thursday: Pray for those affected by

Domestic Violence. Pray for women, children, and men who are victims of domestic violence, asking God to comfort and shelter them in his love, and give them courage to seek help and surround them with people who will act with compassion and wisdom. Pray for those who perpetrate violence, asking God to confront them with the truth of their actions and lead them to repentance and transformation by his Spirit. Pray for our church community to be a place of refuge and justice that seeks to love others with the heart of Christ.

Friday: Pray for those considering

vocational gospel ministry. Praise God that he raises up workers for his gospel mission. Give thanks for the opportunity to gather last Sunday to help those considering to gain clarity and move forward in their thinking and plans towards vocational gospel ministry. Ask that God help them grow in conviction, character, and competency as they continue to have conversations, make plans, and deliberate decisions for the future. Pray that Jesus would send more workers into his harvest.

Saturday: Pray for Sonja Graml serving

with AFES at USQ Toowoomba. Pray for her as she trains students to lead Growth Groups, that it would bear fruit in the lives of the students and their churches. Pray for the National Training Event, and the mission to follow, that students will be trained to love and share the gospel, understand and teach God's Word, and be humble and willing servants on mission. Pray for safe travels and for God's sustaining grace during these weeks.
