Titus 1:1-16

Godliness and Sound Teaching

Church leaders must hold fast to godliness and teach what is true so that the church may be firm in their faith and not be led astray by false teachers

Prayer Points

Monday: Give thanks for God's Word.

Give thanks for God reminding us in Acts that the gospel of Jesus stands vindicated before the world, that it is for all nations, and that it advances without hindrance. Praise God that his gospel has advanced across space and time all the way to Brisbane, Australia, so that we could hear, believe, and be saved. Pray that God would use us to continue proclaiming his gospel with all boldness to the ends of the earth.

Tuesday: Pray for the AFES National Training Event.

Praise God for the 2,200 students from universities across Australia gathering in Canberra to be transformed by the gospel, trained in the gospel, and sent with the gospel. Give thanks for the opportunity for students to sit under God's Word in main sessions and learn how to read and teach God's Word in strand groups. Pray for opportunities for students to be thinking about how they can be serving God's mission both now and in the future.

Wednesday: Give thanks for the baptisms held and the opportunity to celebrate new life in Christ.

Give thanks for the way God has graciously worked in the lives of those baptised to bring them to faith and salvation in Jesus. Pray that God would use them to proclaim and bear witness to his gospel. Pray that as a church we would continue to celebrate when Jesus welcomes even one of his lost sheep home.

Thursday: Give thanks for the JKC and PKC Christmas events.

Praise God for many new and returning visitors who came and heard the gospel of Jesus faithfully and clearly taught. Give thanks for the boldness of the kids and their families inviting and bringing their friends to learn about and celebrate the birth of Jesus who is the saviour of the world. Pray for opportunities to invite these friends back to church over the Christmas period and in the new year. Pray for these kids to know Jesus as their saviour and as their king.

Friday: Pray for all those affected by the tropical storms across South and Southeast Asia.

Ask God to look in mercy on those whose lives and possessions have been threatened and destroyed by flooding and landslides. Pray for the governments of Sri Lanka, Indonesia, Vietnam, Thailand, and the Philippines to respond quickly and effectively. Ask that God would give comfort to those whose lives and livelihoods have been affected.

Saturday: Pray in response to God's Word.

Pray that what God speaks to us through Titus this morning would take root in our hearts. Pray that as a church we would hold fast to godliness and teach what is true. Pray for our church leaders to teach the true gospel and to live this out in their own lives. Pray that churches would rebuke those who profess to know God but deny him by the way they live.
