

Grace and Godliness

Christians must adorn the beauty of godliness toward one another because of the grace shown to us through Jesus.

Prayer Points

Monday - Titus 1 and 2

Give thanks that God’s Word is good for all of us! Pray that as we reflect on the need for godliness in ourselves and our leaders – because of growing false teaching and the need for gospel clarity and discernment – that we would grow in maturity as a body. Pray that God would keep raising up faithful men and women to lead and serve His body through the generations, and pray that we would be faithful in raising them up.

Tuesday - Family Holidays

Give thanks for holiday periods beginning for students and families. Pray for a good time of rest and rejuvenation. Pray in particular that many among us who are feeling the weariness of the year would finish well and faithfully. Pray that times of catching up with family and other social gatherings would be refreshing for our minds and bodies.

Wednesday - Christmas Service

Pray for preparations for our upcoming Christmas service as we consider the gift of Jesus and what that reveals about the giver: God the Father. Ask that God would help us prayerfully invite friends and family to come and hear this wonderful news – and pray that our gathering would help draw those far away towards God and the gospel.

Thursday - Advent

Give thanks for the Christmas season, a wonderful time and reminder that God has not left us in sin and darkness, but light has come into the world. Pray that as work winds down, holidays begin, and festive gatherings are held, that the good news of Jesus’ birth and incarnation would help us pause, give thanks, and speak boldly about our hope of eternal life.

Friday - Graduates

Give thanks for the many students who call SLE Church home during their studies in Brisbane. Give thanks that as the graduates finish up and head home that they would connect well into churches and be a blessing. Pray that this season of returning home and resetting life would not be an excuse to avoid church, but would compel them to find and connect with faithful gospel communities that will disciple and encourage them on this long Christian race.

Saturday - K’s Ministry

Pray for K, our supported missionary, who is in a Muslim-majority country. Give thanks as Brianna, a girl that K has been meeting, accepted Christ as her Lord and Saviour! Pray that Brianna will keep growing in maturity in Christ, loving her family despite the persecution she faces from them.
