

The Season of Delighting in Devoted Love (Song of Solomon)

The love shared between lovers can be profoundly passionate and powerful - and is therefore something to be received with delight and handled with reverent care.

Prayer Points

Monday – Ecclesiastes

Praise God for the resurrection of Jesus and give thanks that this means death is not the end. Give thanks that in the midst of the mess and confusion of this world, we can truly make sense of life because Jesus' resurrection redefines reality. Ask God to help us to live for him, to teach us to fear him, and to compel us to enjoy his good gift of life in Jesus.

Tuesday – Song of Songs

Give thanks to God for love as his good gift. Pray for wisdom to receive love with delight, self-control, and patience to wait for it rightly. Pray that our longings, disappointments, and contentment would find their ultimate hope not in human relationships, but in Jesus and the future he has promised. Ask that God would shape our lives—whether married or single—to reflect his love with faithfulness, gentleness, and hope as we wait for Christ's return.

Wednesday – Re-Ignite

Give thanks for the incredible encouragement the evening was, gathered together with brothers and sisters in Christ, singing praise to Him, and hearing from his word. Give thanks for the 230 people from churches all over Brisbane (and beyond) who gathered to hear from Dave Walter on 1 Kings 21 about outrageous grace. Ask God to be working in those who attended to be trusting in him in every aspect of their life, and to be sharing this life-transforming news with others.

Thursday – Ignite Training Conference

Praise God for the precious opportunity for brothers and sisters around Brisbane and beyond to gather and dig deep into God's word for a week at the Ignite Training Conference this past week. Thank God for the reminder and exhortation from 1&2Kings to listen, trust, and obey His Word because He is our Holy God, the creator and controller of all things. Pray that those who attended will be spurred on to proclaim Jesus boldly, to pray for all to turn to Him. Pray that they will be encouraged to cling to the unwavering hope grounded in Christ's death and resurrection even when the world rejects them for bringing the good news of Jesus. Pray too that God will use the attendees mightily in their churches across the nation for His purposes and glory.

Friday – Ministry teams

Pray that God would give wisdom to ministry teams as they make plans for the new year. Pray for team leaders to lead well and envision their team members to joyfully and sacrificially serve God for the sake of growing people in maturity in Jesus and investing in the next generations. Give thanks for those in SLE who give their time and energy to serve others.

Saturday – Iran

Pray that God would bring peace, protection, and wisdom for the people of Iran amid violence and uncertainty. Ask that God would give comfort to families who have lost loved ones, and healing for those injured and traumatised. Pray for Iranian Christians to have courage, protection, and perseverance as they live out the gospel. Pray that God's light would shine through the church in Iran, bringing true freedom, dignity, and hope in Jesus.
