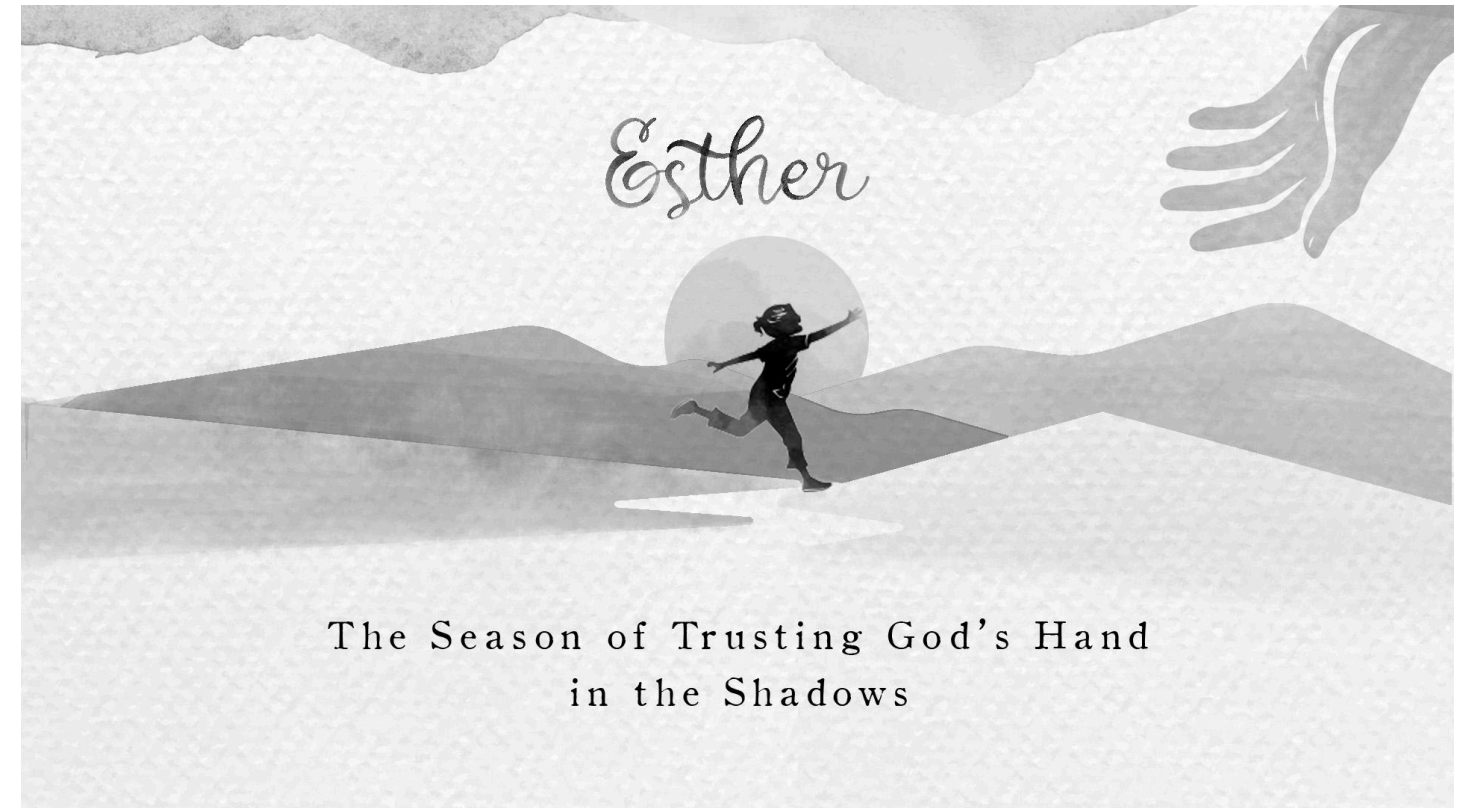

Prayer Points

Monday – Australia

Give thanks for the work of the gospel in Australia. Praise God for the Christians who brought the Christian faith onto our shores, who lived faithfully, loved their neighbours, planted churches, and worked for gospel growth in their own generation and for generations to come. Praise God for bringing the nations to our shores so that they might have the opportunity to hear the gospel, grow in their faith, and take the gospel back to their home countries. Pray that God would have mercy on all those who call Australia home, and that he would teach us to trust in his Son Jesus as our Lord and Saviour.

Tuesday – Izzy and Dom

Give thanks to the God of love for giving us the gift of marriage. Give thanks for the joining in marriage of Isabel and Dominic on Saturday. Pray that they would know God’s presence in their joys and in their sorrows, and ask God to deepen their love for each other and sustain them in their commitment and vows. Pray that their marriage would proclaim the love of Jesus to those around them.

Wednesday – Liesl See

Pray for our new ministry apprentice, Liesl See, as she begins training in ministry with our church over the next two years. Pray for God to grow her in her godliness, her humility, and her pastoral heart to serve and care for others. Pray that the training she receives would be fruitful and beneficial for the growth of God’s kingdom, both here and in her future ministry. Pray for her as she invites people to partner in her ministry through prayer and financial support.

Thursday – HET Second Service

Give thanks to God for the life and ministry of Steve Manders, who passed away and graduated to glory on Friday 16 January. Pray for his wife Saeko and his daughter Emilie in Japan, and his mother in Brisbane as they grieve during this difficult time and remember the gift of hope that our Lord Jesus kindly gave us. Pray for the OMF Japan team as they grieve their brother and partner in the gospel who encouraged many of them to develop and grow in their knowledge of the Lord and in service of his church in Japan. Pray that God would comfort all who knew him and who were impacted by his passion and servant heart.

Saturday – Japan

Praise God that salvation in the gospel of Jesus is for all nations. Pray for the over 99% of the population of Japan who have not yet entrusted themselves to the hope of salvation in Jesus. Pray for Japanese Christians and gospel workers in Japan to courageously and carefully preach the gospel to a culture that is heavily influenced by many religious and spiritual beliefs and that still perceives the Christian faith to be a predominantly foreign concept.
