## Prayer Points

---

### Monday – Exodus 1–2

Praise God for his great act of salvation in Jesus and give thanks for his faithfulness to the promises he made to redeem a people for himself. Ask that God would lift our eyes and look to Jesus for assurance in our salvation as we seek to persevere in faith and obedience today. Pray that God would continue to reveal his saving grace to the many in our world who remain enslaved to sin and death.

### Tuesday – Life Course

Praise God that his salvation in Jesus brings true and everlasting life to all who believe in him. Pray for all those volunteering and serving at the Life Course over the next five weeks that they would be motivated by the need for people to hear the gospel and be saved. Pray that as food and drinks are served, tables are decorated and set, and plates are cleared and cleaned, those attending would experience the warmth of the gospel through these actions. Pray that the gospel would be proclaimed clearly and faithfully in both word and deed so that many might receive life in Jesus' name.

### Wednesday – Grow Leaders

Give thanks for our Grow Leaders who serve joyfully and sacrificially in leading their Grow Groups to see people grow as mature disciples of Jesus. Pray for them to keep developing as leaders of God's people as they guide their groups to let the word of Christ dwell among them richly. Pray that they would continue to treasure God's Word for themselves and to model living out God's Word in their own lives for their group members. Ask that God would enable them to pastor and care for their people, and to encourage them to pastor and care for one another.

### Thursday – FIEC Senior Pastors Forum

Give thanks for the opportunity for the Senior Pastors within the Fellowship of Independent Evangelical Churches (FIEC) across Australia to gather earlier last week for a time of refreshment, encouragement, and fellowship. Pray that the plans and decisions made would continue to help plant and grow independent evangelical churches to reach Australia for Christ.

### Friday – University Campus Ministry

Pray for university student ministries as they welcome new students onto campus and make contact with potential newcomers. Pray for opportunities to proclaim the gospel on campus, and for Christians to strengthen their faith and be bold in their witness. Pray that our Sunday YF ministry would likewise help university students to navigate what it looks like to grow personally and spiritually during these transformative years.

### Saturday – International Students

Praise God for bringing international students from all nations to Australia to study and for the opportunities this presents for us to proclaim the gospel and lead them to Christ. Pray that God would be preparing the hearts of those who might hear the gospel, some for the very first time. Pray that we at SLE church would be eager to welcome them into our church community. Pray that International YF would seek to be a community of international students captivated by the Gospel, living their whole lives for Jesus now and beyond university. Pray that the IYF ministry would continue to grow, equip, and send international students for the sake of the gospel.
