

The LORD's Saving Name

The LORD is determined to save His people and will not be thwarted by resistance, filling us with awe that He has come and revealed Himself, giving us assurance that His purposes cannot be stopped, and warning us not to harden ourselves against His saving purposes.

Prayer Points

Monday – Exodus 3–4

Praise God for revealing his name YHWH to his people, and in so doing revealing his commitment to save his people from slavery to sin. Give thanks that we too can call on the name of Jesus to be saved because God followed through on his commitment to redeem his people. Pray that we would continue to trust in the name of Jesus and submit our lives to his Lordship.

Tuesday – Life Course

Pray for those coming along to the Life Course as it kicks off this week, that as they hear about Jesus and the life that he brings, they would come to know and embrace life in him. Pray for the gospel of Jesus to be proclaimed clearly and faithfully, and that people would come to see that Jesus is our only hope in life. Pray that God would save many people through the Life Course this year.

Wednesday – Finances

Give thanks for the generosity of those who give financially to the ministry of SLE Church. Pray that God would give wisdom to the SLE Church Council as they budget our church's finances to enable gospel ministry in St Lucia and beyond. Pray especially for the SLE Finance Committee as they meet to put together the budget for the next financial year. Pray that God would be faithful in providing for and enabling the ongoing ministry and mission of SLE Church.

Thursday – Brisbane School of Theology

Pray for the Brisbane School of Theology as they commence a new academic year and welcome a new cohort of students. Pray that as students go deep in their studies, they would be shaped by God's Word and be formed for ministry, mission, and service. Pray that after a difficult year for the college in 2025 with the sudden loss of their Principal, God would continue his good work amongst the college community as they seek to serve God's church and his world with the gospel.

Friday – Queensland Theological College

Pray for Queensland Theological College as they seek to train up gospel-driven leaders for the local church and the global mission field. Give thanks for the graduating class of 2025 and pray for them as they go out to serve Jesus in their churches, workplaces, schools, and communities. Pray for new students to settle into a rhythm and routine for studying, and pray for continuing students as they get back into study. Pray that what students learn this year would not just be academic, but would deepen their understanding of and relationship with God.

Saturday – HET Second Service

Pray for our sister church Huai En Tang (HET) as they seek to proclaim the gospel to the Chinese-speaking people in our area. Give thanks to God for their growth as a church, both in welcoming new people and in their maturity as disciples of Jesus. Pray for their afternoon service beginning this week to be a strategic opportunity to continue reaching out with the gospel—particularly Chinese-speaking students and young adults.

The LORD's Saving Name (Exodus 3:1-4:31)

Introduction

1. The LORD comes near (3:1-6)

2. The LORD reveals Himself, His plans, and overcomes the resistance of His deliverer (3:7-4:17)

a. The LORD has surely seen, heard, and knows... (3:7-10)

b. "Who am I that I should go?" (3:11-12)

c. "Who are you?" (3:13-22)

d. "But... they won't believe me..." (4:1-9)
