THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST

1 Corinthians 15:1-16:24

The Resurrection Of Christ

The resurrection is not just the happy ending to the story of Jesus – it is the truth that holds the whole Christian faith together. On Easter Sunday, we'll see why Paul insists that if Christ has not been raised, we are left in a terrible mess: still in sin, without hope, and with nothing solid to stand on. But because Christ has been raised, everything is different. Our labour is not in vain, our future is secure, and our hope is alive.

Prayer Points

Monday – Thanksgiving for Easter

Give thanks for Easter weekend – for Jesus' death in our place on Good Friday and his resurrection to life and Lordship on Easter Sunday. Praise God that sin is forgiven, death is defeated, and new life is offered in Christ. Pray that the good news of the gospel would keep ringing out in our world – and not just be heard, but take deep root in our hearts, shaping our trust, our repentance, and our daily obedience.

Tuesday – Rest and Refreshment

Pray for families and students during the school holidays – that this would be a time of genuine rest, joy, and reconnection. Pray especially for Pastor Steve, Pastor Richard, and their families as they take leave – that God would grant deep physical, emotional, and spiritual refreshment, guarding them from distraction and weariness, and restoring them for the work ahead.

Wednesday – Global Conflict and the Church in Iran

Continue to pray for the conflict involving Iran – asking God for a swift resolution, restraint from further escalation, and the preservation of life. Pray for Iranian Christians – that they would stand firm in faith under pressure, know the nearness of Christ, and be given courage and wisdom to bear witness to the gospel even in hardship.

Thursday – Evangelism and Witness

Pray for our witness to friends, family, and colleagues – that God would be preparing hearts to hear and receive the gospel. Ask for boldness, clarity, and love as we speak about Jesus – that we would not shrink back in fear, but speak faithfully and graciously, trusting God to work.

Friday – Generosity and Church Finances

Pray for our church's financial needs, especially as the budget has been tightening – asking that God would continue to provide for the work of the gospel among us. Pray that He would be at work in all of us to grow in joyful, sacrificial generosity – not out of pressure, but out of gratitude for the grace we've received in Christ. Pray that we would see our giving as a partnership in the gospel – sharing in the ministry of making Christ known, and investing in work that bears eternal fruit.

Saturday – Growth through 1 Corinthians

Pray for our church as we journey through 1 Corinthians – that God would use His word to expose where we are not living under the cross of Christ. Ask that He would both challenge and comfort us – humbling us where we are proud, correcting us where we are off-track, and reassuring us of His grace as we seek to live for Him together.
