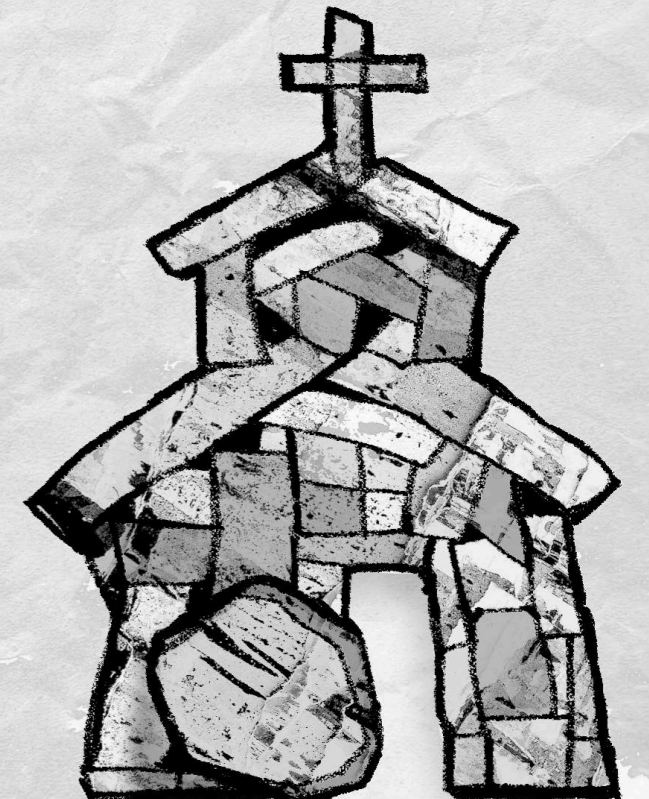

The Gospel for a Proud Church

Division in the church is caused by pride and jealousy, but the gospel humbles and unites.

Prayer Points

Monday - 1 Corinthians 3 & 4

Praise God that His wisdom is Jesus Christ crucified! Thank God that He gives us his wisdom through his spirit. Pray that as Christians we will boast of God's wisdom revealed in Jesus rather than human leaders, and for humility before God as He alone judges rightly and gives growth to his churches.

Tuesday - New School Term

Thank God for rest and time families could spend together during the term break. Pray that as a new term starts, God will sustain both children and teachers for the coming weeks of school. Pray for wisdom for the parents as they continue to disciple their children in the midst of packed schedules. Pray that the children would grow in confidence in living out Jesus as their King.

Wednesday - Kids Church

Thank God for the short breather that the kids church teachers could have in the term break. Pray that the teachers will continue to teach the children faithfully, and that they will partner well with the parents to disciple the children.
