THE GOSPEL AND UNDIVIDED DEVOTION

1 Corinthians 7:25-40



The Gospel and Undivided Devotion

In these last days believers should hold their earthly things lightly and pursue undivided devotion to the Lord.

Prayer Points

Monday – 1 Corinthians 7

Pray for God's Word to nourish, encourage, rebuke, and challenge us as we seek to live in faithfulness to Jesus. Ask that God might lift our eyes to see the eternity that awaits those who are saved in the gospel, and pray that all other earthly and temporary things might not distract or entice us away from this. Pray that we might pursue undivided devotion towards our Lord Jesus.

Tuesday – Mother's Day

Give thanks to God for our mothers, for the women who gave us birth or adopted us and raised us and cared for us. Give thanks also for our spiritual mothers, for the women who pray for us and minister to us and nurture us spiritually. Pray for those who struggle through the grief of having lost their mothers or are estranged from their mothers that God might give them comfort. Pray that as a church we would lament with those who struggle as mothers, or long to be mothers, or who as mothers have lost children too soon, and ask that God would comfort and heal.

Wednesday – Elder Mike Husband

Pray for Elder Mike Husband as he seeks medical care to investigate and treat some concerns with his heart. Pray for his upcoming appointment with his cardiologist, that a diagnosis and a wise course of treatment would be pursued. Pray that God would protect his heart in the meantime, and that any surgery/procedures would be successful in treating his illness. Pray that he and Auntie Yin-Leng would find appropriate help to care for them both while Uncle Mike is in recovery.

Thursday – Centenary Evangelical Church

Give thanks to God for his faithfulness in growing and sustaining Centenary Evangelical Church since they were planted in 2023. Give thanks for their growth as they seek to proclaim the gospel of Jesus to the lost and de-churched in the Centenary suburbs and beyond. Pray for them as they seek a new venue to meet from the end of June onwards. Pray that God would grant them wisdom and clarity as they weigh up and double-check options, and pray that God would faithfully place the church where they can best serve him and his kingdom.

Friday – SLE Church Finances

Give thanks for the faithfulness and generosity of those who give financially to the ministry of SLE Church. Pray that God would give wisdom to the SLE Church Council as they budget our church's finances to enable future gospel ministry in St Lucia and beyond. Pray that God would be faithful in providing for and enabling the ongoing ministry and mission of SLE Church. Pray in particular for the financial capacity to bring on and raise up more gospel workers, as well as multiply ministry with new services and church plants, so that the gospel would go out and make more disciples of Jesus.

Saturday – Taste and See #1

Give thanks for the first session of Taste and See and for the many explorers who came along to experience the first part of God's story. Give thanks for the conversations shared, the connections formed, and the questions pondered and asked. Pray for our guests, both adults and kids, that God would give them a soft heart towards the gospel so that they would truly taste and see God's goodness in the gospel and through his people.
