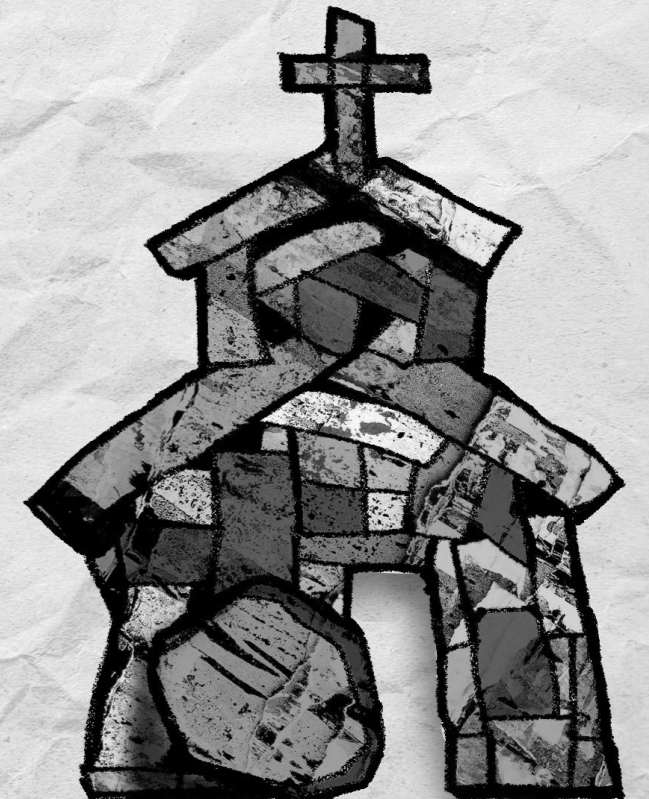

THE GOSPEL AND THE LORD'S SUPPER

1 Corinthians 11:17-34



The Gospel and the Lord's Supper

The Lord's Supper proclaims Christ's self-giving death for his one body, so we must not receive it in ways that divide or despise that body.

Prayer Points

Monday - 1 Corinthians 11

Praise God that in His loving kindness to seek and save the lost, He gave the perfect offering of Jesus' life to pay the cost and take our place on the cross. Thank God that we are invited to take part in the Lord's Supper to remember His saving grace in Jesus. As believers take the Lord's Supper weekly at SLE, pray that we will not take it in ways that divide or despise the body of Christ, but in ways that reflect our gratitude and oneness as a church.

Tuesday - Magnification

Praise God that in His mercy and grace He has gathered us to be His holy and treasured possession. Pray that each Sunday our gatherings will proclaim His excellencies deeply and warmly, for the building up of believers and for Jesus to be made known to seekers. Pray that as we gather each week SLE will be a church that magnifies God's glory both from the pulpit and the pew, and that the lives we live daily will ever only be for the glory of Jesus' name.

Wednesday - Kids' Church

Thank God for term 2 at Kids' Church where the teachers and parents could partner together to help grow the children's understanding and love for God through the learning of Old Testament kings and "Why do I" series. Pray for a time of rest for the teachers during the term break, and for sustenance and wisdom as parents continue to faithfully disciple their children in following Jesus.

Thursday - Winter Break

As the winter break approaches, pray for safety for international and interstate friends among us who will be travelling or returning home. For all staying in Brisbane, pray for a restful time and for relationships to continue to be built and strengthened both with fellow believers and with those who have not put faith in Jesus. Pray that wherever we may be during this break, we'll not take a break from maturing as His disciples and growing our compassion for the lost.

Friday - Kezia with *Power to Change*

Praise God for the time spent with the Power to Change team in Korea where they were deeply encouraged by the locals' heart for Jesus, and pray that the team will be able to apply what they have learnt on the trip. Praise God too for the 4 new conversions this semester, and pray for the 5 seekers attending the upcoming Winter Conference that God will open their hearts to the good news of the gospel. Pray also for generous hearts that will partner financially with Kezia for the cause of the gospel.

Saturday - Philippines

Pray for all affected by the earthquake in The Philippines last Monday, that practical help and relief will reach them timely. Pray for God's comfort to be with those among us who have family or friends who were affected, and for God to comfort the families there who have lost loved ones, and for healing for the injured and traumatised. Pray also for the Filipino Christians to cling tight to our compassionate Lord Jesus in this very difficult time.
