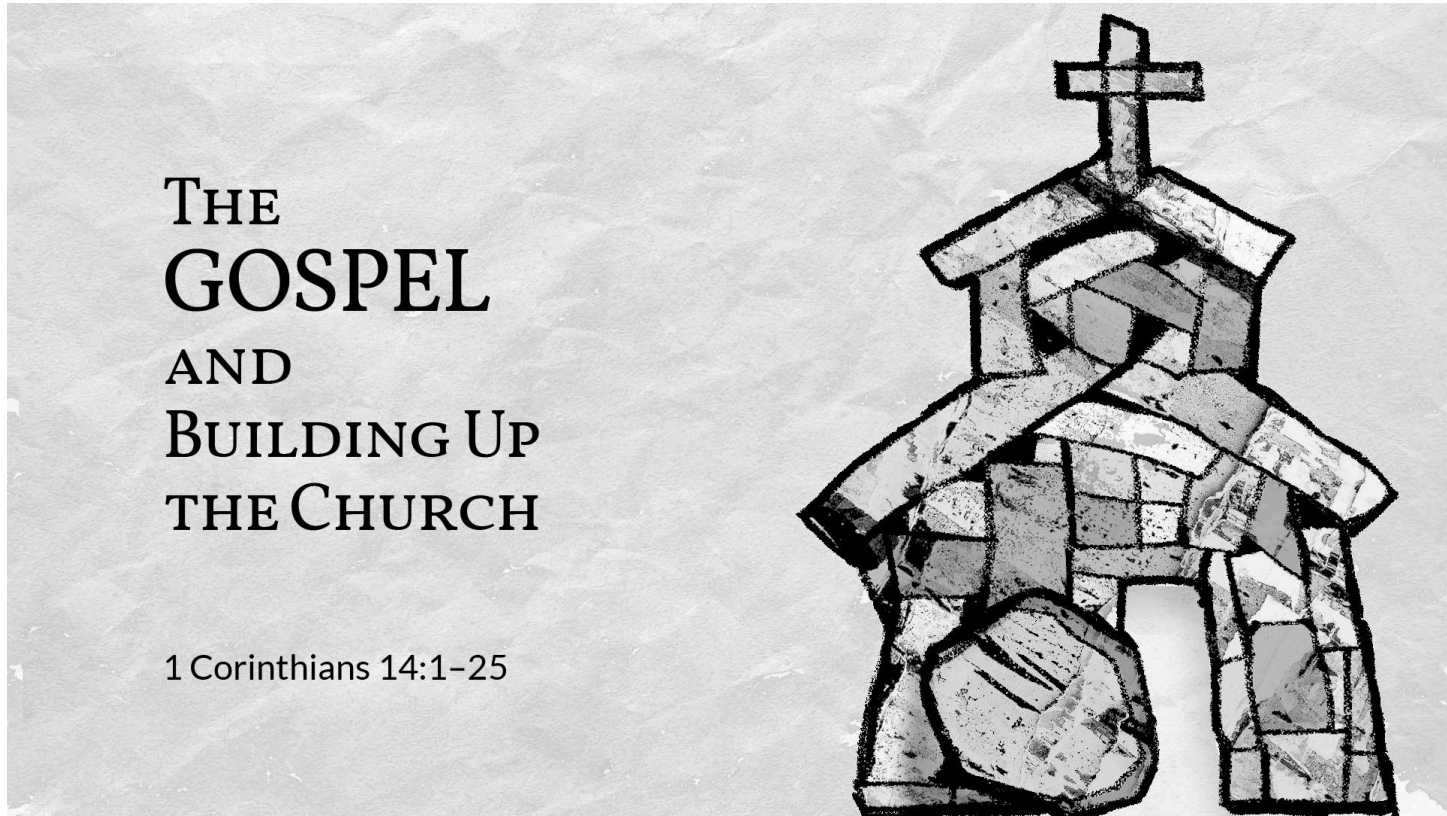

The Gospel And Building Up The Church

When Christians gather together, they speak the gospel into the lives of both believers and unbelievers so that Jesus’ church is built up.

Prayer Points

Monday - 1 Corinthians 14

Praise God that He graciously gives His people diverse gifts! Pray that SLE as a community will use different gifts to build the church up in love. Ask that God grows our hearts to desire and cultivate speech that brings gospel truths to bear in each others' lives and situations so that others can be edified, encouraged, instructed and convicted.

Tuesday - Ministry

Thank God for our pastors and leaders who care for the flock of God's people. As they faithfully carry on equipping us through the Word, that God will sustain them and give them wisdom as they look to continually build up a body of Christ in maturity and in ever-increasing numbers. Ask God to grow the desire in more brothers and sisters to step up to serve others with gifts they have been given, and for more to consider full-time ministry in order to reach the plentiful harvest.

Wednesday - University Students

Thank God for semester 1 at uni that has passed and for the winter break. As the new semester starts in a month, pray that new uni students will get used to uni life in their own time and find a church to settle in. Pray that churches in Brisbane including SLE Church will be a warm and welcoming community to those who come through our doors. Ask God to transform their hearts through the Spirit with the clear teaching of the gospel, that they will desire to live boldly for Jesus even when others in uni despise or ridicule them.

Thursday - Upcoming LIFE Course

Praise and thank God that in Jesus those who believe have everlasting life with Him! Pray for the team who are preparing to serve in the different areas that God will grow their hearts for the loss. Pray also for courage and intentionality as a church to be inviting friends and family to hear about the life-giving God who is mighty to save.

Friday - Venezuela Earthquake

Pray for the many people affected by the twin earthquakes in Venezuela on 24 June, that practical help and relief will reach them as quickly as possible. With an estimated 50,000 people still missing, pray that God will sustain those involved in the massive search and rescue efforts. Ask God to comfort the families who have lost loved ones, and for healing for the injured and traumatised. Pray for the Venezuelan Christians to cling tight to our compassionate Lord Jesus in this chaotic and devastating period.

Saturday - Christians in North Korea

Pray for our brothers and sisters in North Korea, the world's most dangerous place to worship King Jesus. Thank God that in His sovereignty and compassion, He continues to sustain and protect Christians there who follow Him in secrecy despite fear of being sent to labour camps or even executed. Pray that as many believers worship alone, that they will experience fellowship with God when human fellowship is almost impossible, and for comfort as they look forward with hope to the day that they'll be gathered together with the multitudes around the throne of their Saviour and King.
