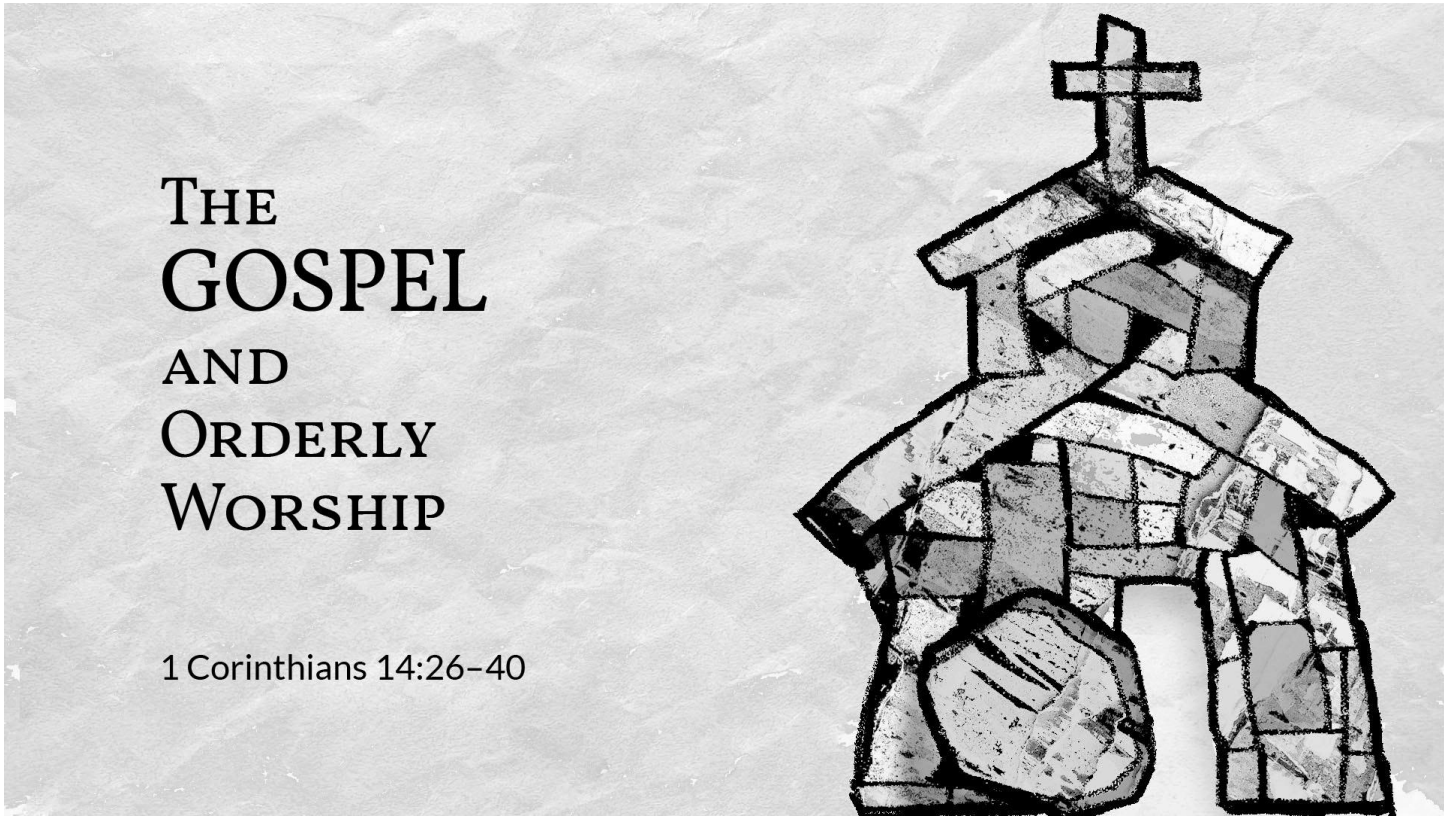

The Gospel And Orderly Worship

When Christians gather together, they must ensure the gospel is communicated rightly and clearly so that it builds up Jesus’ church.

Prayer Points

Monday - 1 Corinthians 14

Praise God that when Christians gather together, we display the beauty of Christ’ body. Praise God that He gives His Spirit, His word and His people for the building up of Christ’ body. Pray that when Christians gather together, we would value, uphold, and cultivate gospel speaking that is correct, clear, and beneficial for growing one another in maturity in Christ.

Tuesday - Gospel Generosity

Praise God for revealing the gospel and for giving His beloved Son, who shows the fullness of God’s generosity in love, sacrifice, and service so that His people would have the means to live as His. Praise God for blessing us richly as He calls us to live for Him. Pray that we would respond with Gospel Generosity—offering our gifts, energy and money for the growth and maturity of Christians and those who will come to know Christ. Pray that God would shape our hearts to delight in giving toward what He loves.

Wednesday - Taste & See Follow Ups

Thank God for bringing over 30 guests (plus children) to hear the gospel through Taste and See, and for the impact of Bible teaching and personal testimonies.

Pray for ongoing follow ups with many guests who want to keep exploring Jesus and connect with our church community. Ask the Holy Spirit to deepen their understanding of the gospel, bring conviction and faith, and lead them to willingly bow their knees to Christ as King.

Thursday - Schooling Families

Thank God for the families and children who have been part of our Sunday gatherings over the holidays. Pray that the Lord’s presence and peace would help them transition back into school and term routine. Pray for energy, health, friendships, and learning. Ask that in all these areas, families would know the joy of living for Jesus, that their presence in school communities would point others to the light of Christ.

Friday - Primary Kids Church (PKC) Term 3

As Kids Church resumes for Term 3, pray that PKC leaders and families would partner well to disciple the children and share the gospel with visitors. Pray that as PKC leaders and families hear God's Word in 1 Corinthians, they would embrace being part of God's family and be encouraged to live for Jesus.

Saturday - Junior Kids Church (JKC) Term 3

Thank God for the many JKC teachers who have served faithfully over the years. As some step down to serve in other ministries, pray that they continue to serve with willing hearts and keep the gospel central. Praise God for the new teachers joining the team, and pray that their onboarding would be smooth and filled with joy as they show Jesus to the children. As families return for Term 3, pray that the children would be eager to hear God's Word and grow in awe of Jesus. Pray also that the upcoming JKC Family Picnic would strengthen relationships between teachers and families so that together we can partner well in discipling the next generation.
