The Kingdom’s Immeasurable Worth

The Kingdom’s immeasurable worth is supremely valued by those who discover it and rejected by those who think they already know the King.

Prayer Points

Monday – Matthew 13

Praise God for his sovereignty: that in the face of real evil, the kingdom of heaven grows unstopably, and its future greatness and final judgement are assured. Praise God that the kingdom Jesus proclaims is immeasurable in worth and treasured by those who discover it. Praise God that his kingdom is now plainly revealed in Christ, leaving no excuse for rejecting him.

Tuesday – Repent: Hearts Slow to Hear and Eyes Slow to See

Ask God for forgiveness where we think we already know the King, yet our hearts resist believing and our ears resist hearing his truth, and our eyes continue to seek the comfort in what this world offers. Pray that God would forgive us for seeking comfort apart from him, for disregarding his promises, and forgetting the purpose for which he has saved us.

Wednesday – Uncle Paul Tan and Family

Give thanks for the faithful saints among us. Give thanks especially for Uncle Paul's life - for his joy in Christ and the faithfulness in living for Christ and leading others to know and love Christ. Praise God for the assurance of eternal life through Christ as Uncle Paul awaits his homecoming. Pray for Aunty Daisy and the extended family, that they would know deeply the comfort, peace and nearness of God in this season of grief and waiting.

Thursday – EU (Evangelical Union) Conference, Katoomba

Pray for Pastor Richard's involvement with the Sydney University students at the EU conference in Katoomba, that the good news of God's kingdom would take deep root in their hearts. Pray that the conference would give courage to many as God's Spirit convicts them to leave the comforts of Sydney to serve churches elsewhere.

Friday – A Budget Captivated by Gospel Generosity

Pray for SLE Church, as we learn examples of God at work elsewhere, our hearts would be captivated by the truth of the gospel and move toward joyful, sacrificial generosity. Pray that God's generosity toward us in Christ would shape the way we think about our own budget - our time, gifts, and giving, so that our investment in the mission field before us, both in our city and beyond, reflects deep trust in God's kingdom priorities, valuing what he values and giving toward what grows his kingdom. Pray that we would rest in the uncomfortableness when tension arises between what we want in a worldly sense and what we want in a kingdom sense, and that we would grow in gladness as his gospel reshapes our priorities.

Saturday – Wisdom for Church Leaders

Pray for wisdom for our church leaders in financial stewardship, faithful shepherding, and wise planning; that they would humbly depend on God to care for the people whom God brings as he grows our church. Pray that God would give clarity and unity for the leaders in our overflow situation.
