The Messiah's mercy overflows Israel's borders, welcoming outsiders who come in humble faith and providing abundantly for the nations.

Prayer Points

Monday – Welcoming the Outsider

Give thanks that in Jesus, God has graciously welcomed us when we were outsiders, undeserving of his mercy. Pray that as we reflect on Matthew 15:21–39, we would see afresh the wideness of God’s compassion and grace. Ask God to make SLE a church that warmly welcomes those who are searching, unfamiliar, different from us, or unsure whether they belong. Pray that our welcome would point people beyond ourselves to the welcome found in Christ.

Tuesday – Unbelievers in Our Midst

Give thanks that God continues to bring people among us who are curious, searching, and willing to consider the claims of Jesus. Pray especially for the final session of Life Course – that those who have been listening would come to a saving knowledge of Jesus and put their trust in him. Ask God to bring clarity where there is confusion, conviction where there is unbelief, and faith where there is hesitation. Pray also for fruitful and honest conversations as people continue to explore the gospel.

Wednesday – Older Generations

Give thanks for the older generations among us, and for the many ways their faithfulness, service, sacrifice, and prayers have paved the way for those who have followed. Pray that God would sustain them in faith and enable them to finish the race well, with their hope firmly fixed on Christ. Ask God to help all of us keep growing in grace throughout every season of life. Pray that we would intentionally model godliness and invest what we have received into the generations coming after us.

Thursday – Floods in Nepal

Pray for those affected by the tragic flash floods in Nepal, especially those who have lost loved ones, homes, and livelihoods. Ask God to sustain rescue workers and emergency services, and pray that more lives might yet be saved. Pray for comfort for those who are grieving and provision for communities facing enormous loss. Ask God to strengthen his church in Nepal to be a shining light, offering practical compassion and the enduring hope of Christ.

Friday – More Workers for the Harvest

Jesus tells us that the harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Pray that the Lord of the harvest would raise up and equip more people for ministry, leadership, and faithful service. Ask God to give people at SLE a growing willingness to use their gifts, take responsibility, and serve wherever there is need. Pray that our church would increasingly become a place that grows, invests in, and sends workers into God’s harvest.

Saturday – Holiness in Our Leaders

Pray that God would guard the holiness, purity, and integrity of those who lead and teach us. Ask him to protect our leaders from hypocrisy, temptation, pride, and secret sin, so that their lives increasingly align with the gospel they proclaim. Pray that they would find deep satisfaction in Christ rather than seeking fulfilment in ministry success, recognition, or influence. Ask God to help them persevere faithfully, keeping watch over both their life and doctrine.
