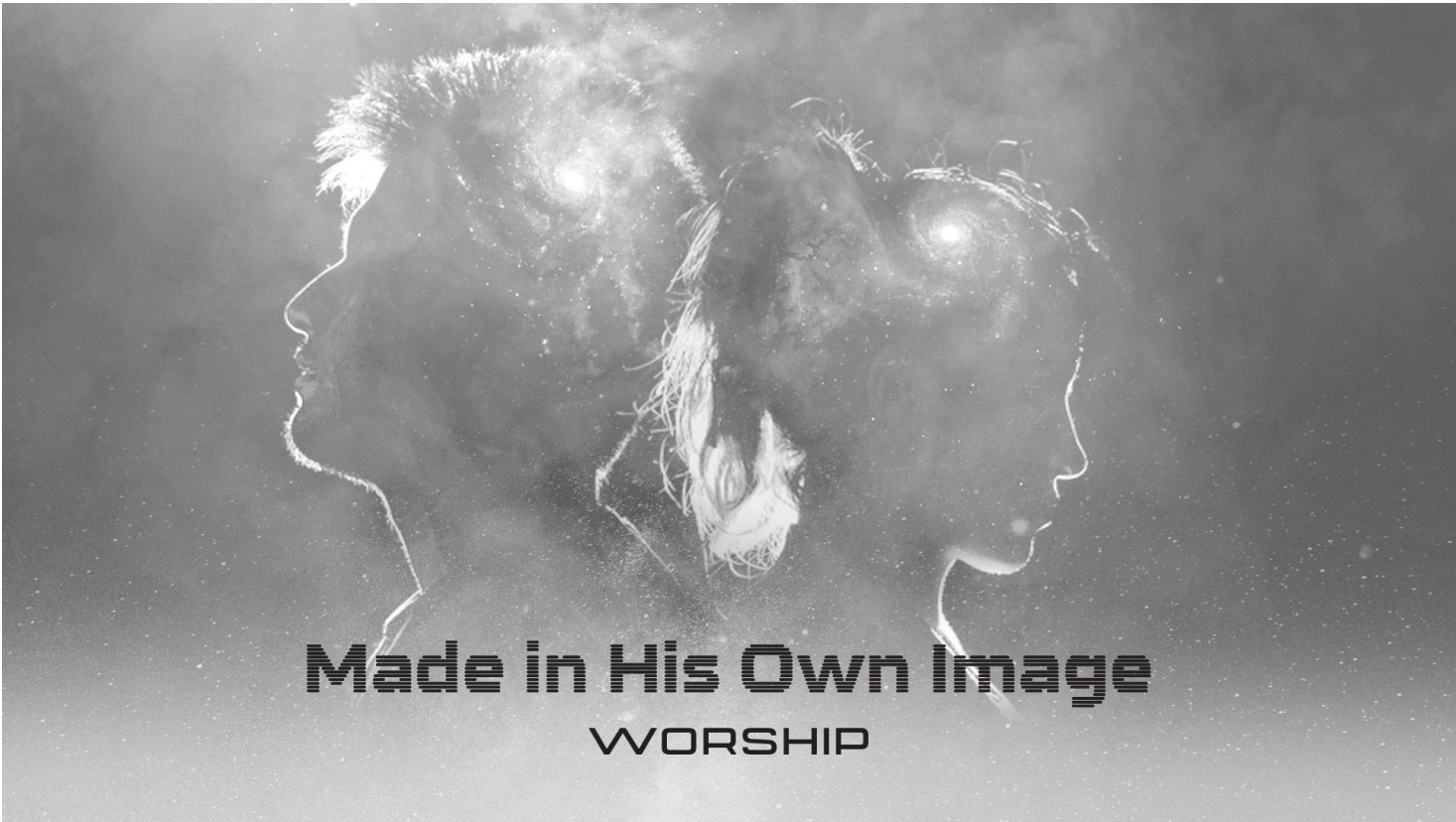

God made us to love and worship him, and we do this by trusting Jesus to make us more like him.

Prayer Points

Monday – The Kingdom Hidden and Revealed

Give thanks for all we have learned through our sermon series in Matthew 13–16. Pray that we would treasure Jesus and his kingdom, trusting his promises and putting him first in our everyday decisions. Ask God for endurance to remain faithful through difficulties and distractions, and for opportunities to encourage one another to persevere. Pray that the truths we have heard would take root in our hearts and bear fruit in lives devoted to Jesus.

Tuesday – Made in His Own Image

Give thanks for our new sermon series, and pray that we would receive God’s Word with joy and teachable hearts. As we approach some challenging topics in the weeks ahead, ask God for grace to listen carefully, speak gently, and respond faithfully. Pray for repentance wherever we have failed to honour others as people made in his image. Ask that our church would joyfully live out God’s vision for humanity, showing our world the goodness of his ways.

Wednesday – School Holidays

Give thanks for God’s care for our families throughout the school term, and pray that the holidays would bring rest and refreshing time together. Give thanks for our Kid’s Church teachers and their faithful work in helping our children know and love Jesus. As children join our services, pray that they would feel welcome and enjoy a wonderful taste of “big church”. May they see the joy of gathering as God’s people as we sing the gospel, hear his Word, and encourage one another.

Thursday – Church Life

Give thanks for the recent weddings of Daniel and Emma, Joshua and Jenny, Joshua and Sarah, and former SLE member Kezia and Guiliano. Pray that God would strengthen these marriages in love and faithfulness. Ask for comfort for those grieving loved ones, including the families and friends of Paul Tan and Molly Teo. Rejoice, too, in the new life God has graciously given those who have recently come to trust Jesus for salvation. In every season, pray that we would rejoice with those who rejoice and weep with those who weep, caring for one another with patience, gentleness, and gospel hope.

Friday – Generosity

Pray that God would grow generous hearts in us as we consider how we give to the life and ministry of our church. Give thanks for the privilege of serving his mission through our finances, time, and gifts. Pray that our giving would help prepare for additional staff who can strengthen our ministries and help them flourish. For those yet to begin giving, ask God to help them take that step joyfully. May we all embrace SLE Church’s vision “to be a community of maturing disciples of Jesus, investing in the next generations”, and give gladly towards this shared work.

Saturday – Y-Conference

Pray for Pastor Steve as he takes leave over the coming weeks, asking God for rest and refreshment for him and his family. Pray also for his preparation to speak from Deuteronomy at Y-Conference over the October long weekend, with more than 200 young adults from churches across South-East Queensland. Ask that those attending would grow in their love for God and see obedience to him as a joyful response to his grace, trusting the goodness of the life he calls us to live. Pray for safe travel and fruitful conversations throughout the conference.
