Pastor's Desk: Year End Reflections (part 1 of 2)

Perhaps, like me, you were shocked to realise that we entered the LAST month of the year during the past week. Has there ever been a year where you've not said to yourself "where has the year gone?"

I suppose any moment in time is suited for reflection on recent events, but it would seem that year ends are particularly suited for reflection on the year about to be ended. Along with all the varieties of year end reviews that we have undergone/are undergoing (e.g. exam results, performance reviews, etc. – all types of year end 'reviews'), why not add in the even more important review of how our Christian walk has gone for 2015? In case you have forgotten (or didn't realise), SLE's theme for the year has been "Everyday with Jesus" – how have you gone with that?

Here's some reflection questions to think through. Why not grab a piece of paper or open up a new document on your device of choice and write down your answers to these questions? Even better, why not compare your answers to a close brother or sister in Christ in the church? And best of all, why not pray on your own and together with that brother or sister about all that you've reflected on? Hopefully there will be plenty of praise points, thanksgiving points, confession and supplication (asking for stuff)!

'Personal walk' questions:

- How have I grown this year in godly character? Identify the specific character traits: in what way particular ways has it grown?
- In what areas of sin and weakness have I remained the same or gotten worse? Why has this been the case?
- How have I grown this year in conviction and devotion to Christ? If so, what specific evidence can I point to? If not, what has been the cause?
- How have I grown in biblical and theological knowledge? Try writing down all the books of the bible you have read, studied in bible study, listened to in sermons and see what you remember from them
- How have I grown in my ability to explain/defend/promote the gospel?
- How have I gone with building relationships this year for the sake of evangelism and discipleship? How has these relationships progressed? What is stunting these from growing more?
- **How has your prayer life been this year?** When are the times/situations you have prayed? When have you not prayed? Can you account for why you are more/less prayerful at different times?

Why not add more reflection questions if you can think of them? Next week, I'll write up a set of reflections for our 'community walk' – how we have gone this year in our service to the church and the world.
